- 4. What does it look like to really mourn over sin, and how are we comforted?
- 5. What does it mean to be humble in the way Jesus is talking about?
- 6. How are we supposed to "hunger and thirst after righteousness"? What kind of righteousness do we long for? How are these people blessed?
- 7. What is the difference between the normal way people say they're blessed (#blessed) and the way Christians use the word (Gospel Blessed)?
- 8. There are no action verbs in these verses... so, what are we supposed to do to be blessed?
- 9. How is being blessed similar to rest?
- 10. What is our response to these beatitudes?
