Questions to help the family dive deeper into the sermon!

1. Who or what is Satan and what does that have to do with us?
2. Is Satan just a metaphor or symbol of evil? Is he really a threat?
3. Is the Devil really that evil? What kind of evil does Jesus describe him as?
4. What are some ways that you can be proactive about fighting this spiritual battle instead of being reactive?
5. Why does Jesus command us to pray for the community? How can you pray for the church family in this way?
6. What are some ways in your life that you can be more dependent on God for victory over evil?
7. Why can we be confident in God's power over Satan?
8. How did Christ triumph over the Devil?
9. How are you experiencing this battle against Satan and evil, and how can confidence in Christ affect your situation?
