In this section we offer information on community providers of gently used and new clothing. This entails undergarments, shirts, slacks, shoes, coats - even gloves, mittens and outerwear.

Most of these items are available seasonally: during the change from summer into fall - cold weather gear becomes more available. Likewise from winter to spring - warm weather clothing becomes available. Most of the sites will also receive gently used and new clothing and apparel items as you outgrow or no longer need them.

As with the food products, there typically is a limit on both the quantity one can receive and the frequency one can visit - every other week - monthly or quarterly might be expected.

Let us not forget: each of us are also called to “Clothe ourselves in the Righteousness of Christ” so that through our acceptance of His ultimate sacrifice on the Cross of Calvary - we too could be Partakers of an ever-lasting relationship with Him.

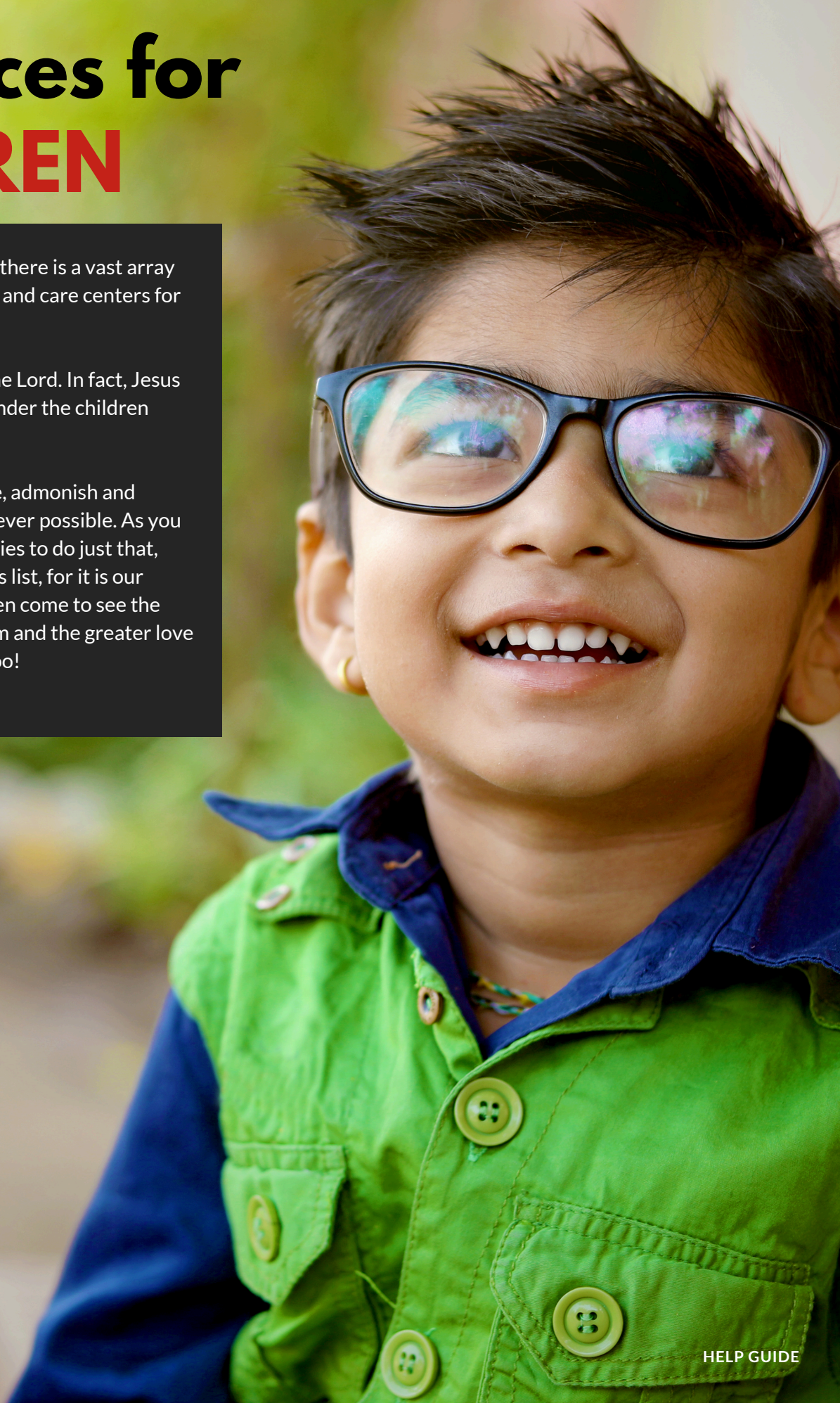
