HEART QUESTIONS: What types of things in your life have caused you to give into despair more

than to hold on to hope in God?

If hope is trusting God to fulfill His promises, what type of promise have you

been hoping in lately?

Does the coming Christmas season elicit a sense of hope for you this year,

or are you experiencing a different emotion?

HANDS QUESTIONS: BLESS

How does living in hope and communicating hope open the door for those

who are far from God to hear the gospel?
