More Alive Than Ever

Galatians 2:20

Read Galatians 2:20 Together:

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

- ? What is the context of this passage? What is happening in the churches of Galatia?
- ? What heresy is the Apostle Paul addressing?

We don't need more **than** the gospel; we just need more **of** the gospel. We will never live a holy life if we think it depends on us!

- ? How does legalism attempt to add to the gospel?
- ? How does the prosperity gospel (health & wealth) attempt to add to the gospel?

We have been united with Christ in his death and his life.

- ? What does Paul mean when he says we have been crucified with Christ? Explain this metaphor.
- ? In what way does Christ live within believers?
- ? How does Paul continue to live united with Christ?
- ? What does "the life I now live in the flesh" mean to you?
- ? If it is not of our power that we live to Christ, how do we live to him?
- ? What does Paul mean when he states that he "lives by faith in the Son of God"? How is this different than our faith at the time of our salvation?

Paul closes out this verse, reminding us that we can be united with Christ because of what he did for us. It is because Christ loved us and gave himself for us that we may live to him.
