

BEREAN KIDS SEVERE WEATHER POLICY

- A severe weather warning indicates a hazard is imminent or the probability is extremely high.
- Children and adults will be asked to remain in the building if a tornado or severe thunderstorm warning has been issued during programming or a special event. Once the conditions warrant allowing children to leave, children may be released to their parents/guardians. Parents will be provided with a safe place to reside if necessary. Children will follow a severe weather plan inside the building to position themselves in the safest areas if it is deemed necessary by a designated weather spotter.
- Parents of children with special needs should discuss with an event leader the best severe weather action plan for their specific child.
