Equality

Disciples of Jesus are the first beachhead for grace, and the last stronghold of truth.

A breakdown in our common understanding of words leads to a society in chaos and distrust.

You say "Equity" and I say "Equality"

Inequalities are everywhere:

- Wages/ homelessness/ gaps in education/ child poverty/ age
- Food insecurity/ healthcare/ incarceration/ disabilities/ credit

Go upstream!

- The symptoms grab our attention. They alert us to a problem
- The source of the problem created the symptoms

What is Equality from a biblical worldview?

Every person has:

- Equal: Value—Human rights—Under law
- Equal: Sinfulness—Spiritual lostness—Calling to the gospel
- Equal: Salvation offered

Matthew 7:12

So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

James 2:8-9

If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well. But if you show partiality, you are committing sin and are convicted by the law as transgressors.

Equality or Equity?

• All offers should be clear and transparent.
