Sand or Seed: ***Faith as a grain of mustard seed.*** Matthew 17:20



As we say farewell to January and hello to February, things continue to roll along in the music ministry. We're thankful for those who step up each week to join us in leading in worship, including the choir and others who sing even when church is canceled, and we can't have our Wednesday night rehearsal.

Musically, we started off the new year with excitement and encouraging participation in most all phases of our ministry, including praise teams, soloists and our male quartet, the Goodtime Singers. We'll continue and expand that in February.

The biggest news in January is that we launched our weekly Easter cantata practices on Wednesday night, Jan. 21, at 7:25 in the choir room. Two nights prior to that we had our cantata listening party at 6:30 in the Truth Seekers classroom. We enjoyed Subway meals, heard the cantata and, perhaps best of all, enjoyed the wonderful fun and fellowship that this group provides. The cantata, titled "Risen Savior, Conquering King," is a powerful Easter musical, 43 minutes in length.



It's not too late to add your voice to the cantata choir. There could be no better time to join us – at least the cantata choir and hopefully the "regular" choir – but if you're wanting to give choir a try, the cantata practice lasts about 10 weeks, and it involves only 30 minutes a week. Please join us! If you sing in both choirs (as the majority do), it still involves only 1 hour a week outside of church services, and we also provide childcare. No more than 1 hour a week is very little to ask in service to God foremost and to this ministry.
