Friendship Modeled After the Good Shepherd (Presence and Vulnerability in the Light of Psalm 23)

Do you have the personal presence of Jesus in your life? If so, how does His presence affect your daily life? If you don't have this, what would you change to receive it?


Is there a role you and I can play as a friend in the lives of others as they face hardships and difficulties?
