When You're Angry

Speaker: Austin Payne

Psalm 4

Unanchored anger destroys. Anger brought honestly to God becomes the ground where trust is rebuilt.

Unanchored Anger Looks Like:

* **Lashing out:** words you can't take back, often directed at the people who are closest to us.

* **Bitterness:** the moment you stop seeing clearly because you're hurt.

* **Nursing it:** replaying the offense until the story calcifies and becomes your identity.

* **The silent shutdown:** not peace, just a powder keg waiting.

Anchored Anger Looks Like:

* **Naming** it to yourself before you say it to anyone else. (James 1:19)

* **Asking:** is this actually wrong? And how am I against it?

* **Bringing** it to God before you bring it to the person who made you angry.

* **Sitting** with it long enough to separate the heat from the substance.

* **Leveraging** your anger into action for the sake of justice.

The silence here isn't suppression. It's examination.

God Gets Angry Too

God's **wrath** is not the opposite of his love.

It is his **love** in action against whatever separates His creation from Himself.

At the **cross**, Jesus absorbed the full weight of that wrath, so you can bring your anger to Him honestly.

Numbers 6:24-26

*"The Lord bless you and keep you;
the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you;
the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."*

God's face toward you is not a reward for having your anger under control. It is the ground you stand on while you work it out.
