Philippians 4:15-17 "And you Philippians yourselves know that in the beginning of the gospel, when I left Macedonia, no church entered into partnership with me in giving and receiving, except you only. Even in Thessalonica you sent me help for my needs once and again. Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that increases to your credit."

The Apostle Paul had a deep love for the Philippian church because of their partnership in the Gospel ministry. He writes in 2 Corinthians how they and others in the Macedonian church gave generously to support the Jerusalem church and Paul's ministry. It is a beautiful picture of the partnership between believers, how we give to support Gospel ministry, and the goal of our giving. Paul says he does not seek the financial gift, but he "seeks the fruit that increases to your credit." Paul's goal is the Gospel fruit, that is people ministered to and disciples made, which comes through the ministry supported by the Philippians' gifts.

As we look to the next fiscal year for Heartland, we partner together as members of the Heartland family, not to seek more financial gifts, but to see Gospel fruit increase among our neighbors and the nations. This happens through the radical generosity of God's people who worship the Lord and minister to others through Heartland Baptist Church. It is these gifts that go to fund children and youth ministries, support international missionaries and North American church planters, provide pastors for our church, pay for utilities, and so much more.

In light of this, I want to ask every member and regular attender to do three things this April:

- 1. Pray for our Stewardship Team as they prepare a budget for FY
- 2. Review the proposed budget when it is distributed in late April.
- 3. Give generously and regularly to support the church's budget as we seek to accomplish our vision to make disciples among our neighbors and the nations. As we consider our stewardship as a corporate body of believers, we should each individually consider our personal giving to the local church.
