
Isaiah 9:2

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone." Isaiah 9:2

As we enter this Advent season, we are stepping into a beautiful journey together through a new sermon series called "The Light Has Come." The weeks leading up to Christmas invite us to slow down, lift our eyes above the noise, and remember that the world's true Light has already dawned in Jesus Christ. In a season filled with lights on Christmas trees and on houses in our neighborhood, we want to take time to focus on the truth that God has sent His Son to shine hope, truth, and salvation into the darkness that people walk in.

Throughout these four weeks and Christmas Eve, we will explore how Scripture reveals Jesus as the promised Light, the dawning Light, the arriving Light, the victorious Light, and finally, on Christmas Eve, the celebrated Light. Each passage—from Isaiah's ancient prophecy to John's proclamation that the Word became flesh—points us to the same truth: Christ came to pierce the darkness with His glory and grace.

Advent is also one of the most meaningful opportunities to invite others to hear the good news of Jesus. People are already thinking about Christmas as they decorate their homes, shop for presents and wrap them, and make plans to visit family. As Christmas is on their minds and Christ's name is on their lips as they sing, people are wondering about hope, meaning, and what



truly matters. A simple invitation can open the door for someone to encounter the Light of Christ, perhaps for the first time.

I want to especially encourage you to invite friends, neighbors, and family members to our Christmas Eve Candlelight Service at 4:00pm. This service is always a powerful, Christ-centered celebration overflowing with Scripture, music, and the beauty of sharing the light together.

Let's pray boldly, invite eagerly, and celebrate joyfully the coming of our Savior with expectant hearts. The Light has come and the darkness cannot overcome it.

LOTTIE MOON CHRISTMAS OFFERING: In 1872, Southern Baptists commissioned Lottie Moon to go to Northern China as a missionary. She spent the next 40 years of her life sharing the Good News of Christ there. Now in 2025, in her honor, we join with 45,000 other churches in giving to send IMB missionaries to the nations. As a church, we have a goal to give \$3,600. To mark our progress, a flag from a different nation will be placed on the platform each Sunday for every \$120 given to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. To give to this special offering, either use the LMCO envelope, write "Lottie Moon" on a HBC offering envelope, or select "Lottie Moon" when giving online.

LOTTIE MOON CHRISTMAS POST OFFICE: Sending out Christmas Cards this year to members and regular attenders at Heartland? Rather than buying a stamp from the US Post Office, send the card with the Lottie Moon Post Office and help send missionaries to the nations at the same time. From November 30—December 14, Heartland kids will receive Christmas cards in the post office set up in the lobby and distribute them to members and regular attenders each Sunday. Make sure to write names on the card/envelope. A suggested donation of 25 cents per card is encouraged. All donations through the Lottie Moon Post Office will go to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering.


**DEACONS' MEETING:** Monday, December 15 at 6pm.
