45% of self-identified Christians in America have not attended church in the past six months. Does this shock you? I know it shocked me when I read it, but experientially I know it to be true when talking with people in our community. This was the stat released by the American Bible Society in "2025 State of the Bible". As we have seen in the "Ekklesia" sermon series, the church is not simply a place we go, but a people we are meant to be a part of. The reality is almost half of self-identified Christians are missing out on the blessing of the biblical community that God has called them to.

On September 21st, churches across America are joining together for "Back to Church Sunday" for a day of outreach inviting people to find biblical community at a local church around them. The theme for this year is "Life Is Better Together". Life truly is better together because God has designed us to know Him and be known by others who loved the Lord too. In a world that is connected more than it has ever been, people are more alone and isolated than they have ever been and this is not the way God desires for us to live. In Christ, we are united to Him and to one another.

As we look to September 21st, think about who you know that is not connected to the church. It may be someone who is not a believer yet. Invite them to church with you. It may be someone who is new to the city and is looking for a church. Invite them to church with you. It may be someone you've noticed has been become disconnected. Invite them to church with you. Most people are very receptive to an invitation to church.

With an increasing openness to conversations about God and truth since the realization of generations that ideologies pushed

by the culture have not answered the questions in people's souls, let us embrace this opportunity for ministry and outreach. Invite someone to join you on September 21st and then don't stop there, but invite people back to church each week.


