Initially streamed on Al Jazeera, grainy and unclear footage of what was believed to be a woman released with a young child and infant. The video showed the three being set free and making their way back to Israel, allegedly taking place on Saturday and later streamed online.

#### Israel directs public hospital to not treat Hamas terrorists

The health minister called on Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to instruct the relevant bodies to act accordingly.

Health Minister Moshe Arbel issued a directive to the public health system in Israel to refuse to treat captured terrorists on Wednesday afternoon.

"Since the beginning of the fighting, the issue of treating the damned and despicable Hamas terrorists within the public hospitals has piled up a tremendous difficulty on the health system," wrote Arbel.

"In these difficult times, the health system should focus fully on the treatment of the victims of the criminal massacre, the IDF soldiers and preparedness for the next," added the health minister. "The task of securing and treating the cursed and despicable terrorists within the public health system significantly harms these efforts and therefore, under my guidance, the public health system will not treat them."

"The handling of the matter should be entrusted to the IDF or the Shin Bet, and of course the Health Ministry is ready and willing to assist these bodies, as needed."

Arbel called on Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to instruct the relevant bodies to act accordingly.

#### What is Hamas?

- Hamas is a Sunni Muslim terrorist group founded in 1987 which won legislative elections in the Gaza Strip in June 2007 after Israel's unilateral withdrawal in August 2005
- Hamas operates as a wholly owned subsidiary of Iran, directed and funded by the Iranians
- Iran does not want Israel to continue normalizing relations with Arab countries in the Middle East, especially Saudi Arabia
- Hamas leaders have been meeting with Russian leaders since the invasion of Ukraine





#### Have you ever read the Hamas charter?

It's worth taking a break from the unrelenting, tragic news to better understand the founding document of the group whose attack plunged Israelis and Palestinians into their current hell. A close reading of Hamas' charter, which was created in 1987 and revised in 2017, explains a lot about its decision to slaughter innocent Jewish civilians, and unleash a reaction that has inevitably claimed innocent Palestinian lives as well. Hamas was founded in 1987 as an Islamic fundamentalist party — an offshoot of Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood. In 2006, a year after Israel withdrew its armed forces and settlers from the Gaza Strip in what is widely known as the disengagement, Hamas won legislative elections, beating the rival Fatah party of Mahmoud Abbas. A year later, it launched a bloody military campaign against Fatah, and took complete control of Gaza.

After Hamas' takeover, Israel imposed a blockade on Gaza, controlling travel and trade in and out of the coastal enclave. Hamas, which the United States, Israel, the European Union, Canada, Egypt, and Japan designate as a terrorist organization, had by 2006 conducted terror attacks in Israel that killed 506 and wounded thousands. After the blockade, the number of attacks plummeted.

Hamas has never changed its aspirations to wrest control of all of Israel by killing its Jews. The first version of the charter, adopted in 1988, begins with a preamble. It reads: "Israel will exist and will continue to exist until Islam will obliterate it, just as it obliterated others before it."

The 36 articles that follow are buttressed by quotes from the Quran and lessons of the Prophet Muhammed ... as interpreted by the militant Islamists of Hamas. After establishing the primacy of Islam, the charter pivots to removing Jews from historic Palestine. "Nothing in nationalism is more significant or deeper than in the case when an enemy should tread Moslem land," states Article 12.

Crucially, the charter codifies Hamas' commitment to violence, which it calls "armed resistance."

"Resisting the occupation with all means and methods is a legitimate right guaranteed by divine laws and by international norms and laws," the document declares. "At the heart of these lies armed resistance, which is regarded as the strategic choice for protecting the principles and the rights of the Palestinian people."

In a 2014 essay, Jeffrey Goldberg called the Hamas charter "a frank and open call for genocide, embedded in one of the most thoroughly antisemitic documents you'll read this side of the Protocols of the Elders of Zion." He titled the essay with a question, "What Would Hamas Do if It Could Do Whatever It Wanted?"



#### What is a kibbutz?

A kibbutz (lit. "gathering, clustering") is an intentional community in Israel that was traditionally based on agriculture. The first kibbutz, established in 1910, was Degania. Today, farming has been partly supplanted by other economic branches, including industrial plants and high-tech enterprises. Kibbutzim began as utopian communities, a combination of socialism and Zionism. In recent decades, some kibbutzim have been privatized and changes have been made in the communal lifestyle. In 2010, there were 270 kibbutzim in Israel with a total population of 126,000.

#### What is a kibbutz?

- It was a revolutionary idea of a voluntary society in which people live in accordance with a specific social contract, based on egalitarian and communal principles in a social and economic framework.
- The main characteristics of Kibbutz life were established in adherence to collectivism in property alongside a cooperative character in the spheres of education, culture and social life. With this came the understanding that the Kibbutz member is part of a unit that is larger than just his own family.
- The Kibbutz operates under the premise that all income generated by the Kibbutz and its members goes into a common pool. This income is used to run the Kibbutz, make investments, and guarantee mutual and reciprocal aid and responsibility between members. Kibbutz members receive the same budget (according to family size), regardless of their job or position. In terms of education, all children start equally and are given equal opportunity.
- The Kibbutz is governed by a system of direct participatory democracy, where the individual can directly influence issues and events in the community. In this mostly self-sufficient community, the collective as well as the work ethic play a major role.
- There are Kibbutzim where the members receive differential salaries and pay for services, but in all the Kibbutzim which have chosen the differentiation model, the members are "insured" regarding the minimum income level.
- Having grown out of the pioneering era and way of thought of the early twentieth century, Kibbutz ideology
  was established and developed during the pre-state and early years of Israel's statehood. During the initial
  years and for many years after, the Kibbutzim assumed prominent roles in almost every sphere of the
  developing country. Although encompassing only three percent of Israeli society, the Kibbutz has made a
  dramatic mark on Israeli production, culture and ideology. https://www.jewishagency.org/what-exactly-is-a-kibbutz/





Nirim is a kibbutz in the northwestern Negev in Israel. Located near the border with the Gaza Strip, about 7 kilometers east of Khan Yunis, it falls under the jurisdiction of Eshkol Regional Council. In 2021 it had a population of 407.





#### Children found 'butchered' in Israeli kibbutz, IDF says, as horror of Hamas' attacks near border begins to emerge

**Kfar Aza, Israel (CNN)** — Bodies of Israeli residents and <u>Hamas</u> attackers lay outside burned-out homes in the Israeli kibbutz Kfar Aza on Tuesday, days after the Palestinian militant group launched a <u>large-scale surprise assault</u> on Israel.

Hamas sent waves of heavily armed fighters pouring across the border from Gaza and rampaging through rural communities – Israel said it found 1,500 bodies of militants in the aftermath of the assault.

Houses in Kfar Aza were ransacked and set ablaze. Overturned mattresses, destroyed furniture, broken trinkets and unexploded grenades lay strewn across the grounds, along with bodies – a window into the scale of devastation wrought by Hamas in this area.

"I've never seen anything like this in my career, never in 40 years of service this something I never imagined," Maj. Gen. Itai Veruv told CNN on Tuesday, just a few hours after Israeli troops secured the kibbutz from Hamas assailants.

### Israeli woman, 25, hailed as a hero for killing terrorists, leading team that saved kibbutz from Hamas

The Hamas was no much for an intrepid 25-year-old Israeli woman — who saved an entire kibbutz from harm by leading a group of residents to kill more than two dozen advancing terrorists, including five she slaughtered herself.

Inbar Lieberman, the security coordinator of Kibbutz Nir Am since December 2022, heard explosions early Saturday, when the terrorists launched their unprecedented attack on the Jewish state. She realized that the sounds were different than those heard during the usual rocket attacks on the kibbutz — located near Sderot and a stone's throw from the Gaza Strip. Lieberman rushed to open the armory, distributed guns to the 12-member security team and coordinated their decisive response amid the unfolding attack. She placed her squad of kibbutzniks in strategic positions across the settlement and set up ambushes that caught the gunmen off guard and turned the tables on them during their mission to inflict mass casualties.

Lieberman killed five terrorists by herself, while the others gunned down 20 more over four hours as they turned Nir Am into an impenetrable fortress — while nearby kibbutzim suffered heavy losses.

Ilit Paz, cultural coordinator at Nir Am, told the news outlet Israel Hayom: "It was amazing. My husband was part of the standby unit that worked to prevent more casualties. They heard the shots and made contact on their own with other members of the standby unit and with Inbal — and they understood that they were told to be on standby.

"But Inbal made a decision not to wait and be jumped operationally. In fact, the fact that they did it early prevented dozens of casualties," she added.

A social media post also lavished praise on the heroic woman, the Maariv daily reported.

"When it's all over, this woman will receive the Israel Prize. The story of her heroism is a story that will go down in Israeli lore for generations. Inbal is the reason there is one kibbutz in the entire surrounding area that remains unharmed — Nir Am," the post said.

As Israel fights its war with Hamas in the Gaza Strip, the battles are being fought from bases across the country. Lior's job is to focus on giving professional and emotional support to her soldiers, who are faced with a war on this scale for the first time. "The tower is like a family," she said. "Everyone is together all the time and working toward a victory." And while the fighting is mainly concentrated in the South, their work in the North is important for the operations in the South, she said.




An Orthodox Jewish man who preferred to remain anonymous stood quietly near the El Al counter at New York's JFK Airport yesterday.




