29 Americans now confirmed dead in Israel: State Department

What is Hamas?

- Hamas is a Sunni Muslim terrorist group founded in 1987 which won legislative elections in the Gaza Strip in June 2007 after Israel's unilateral withdrawal in August 2005
- Hamas operates as a wholly owned subsidiary of Iran, directed and funded by the Iranians
- Iran does not want Israel to continue normalizing relations with Arab countries in the Middle East, especially Saudi Arabia
- Hamas leaders have been meeting with Russian leaders since the invasion of Ukraine



Hamas' use of human shields in Gaza

Hamas, an Islamist militant group and the *de facto* governing authority of the Gaza Strip, has been using human shields in conflicts with Israel since 2007. According to the Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC), the war crime of using human shields encompasses "utilizing the presence of a civilian or other protected person to render certain points, areas, or military forces immune from military operations." Hamas has launched rockets, positioned military-related infrastructure-hubs and routes, and engaged the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) from, or in proximity to, residential and commercial areas.

The strategic logic of human shields has two components. It is based on an awareness of Israel's desire to minimise collateral damage, and of Western public opinion's sensitivity towards civilian casualties. If the IDF uses lethal force and causes an increase in civilian casualties, Hamas can utilise that as a lawfare tool: it can accuse Israel of committing war crimes, which could result in the imposition of a wide array of sanctions. Alternatively, if the IDF limits its use of military force in Gaza to avoid collateral damage, Hamas will be less susceptible to Israeli attacks, and thereby able to protect its assets while continuing to fight. Moreover, despite the Israeli public's high level of support for the Israeli political and military leadership during operations, civilian casualties are one of the friction points between Israeli left-wing and right-wing supporters, with the former questioning the outcomes of the operation.

Meaning, if this document is indeed authentic, the plans to attack the Gaza surrounding settlements were prepared for at least a year.

The detailed plan to attack Kfar Sa'ad is part of a trove of documents that Israeli officials are analyzing, according to one source in the Israeli army and one in the government. Surveillance video of Hamas terrorists entering a kibbutz on Oct. 7 shows tactics similar to those laid out in the documents obtained by NBC News.

Hamas actions are war crimes, could constitute genocide – international law experts

Over 100 authorities from Israel and abroad say terror group's massive attack was intended to destroy part of a national group, hostage-taking involved multiple crimes

Over 100 experts on international law issued a statement Sunday assessing that the Hamas terror group committed multiple war crimes in its massive assault on Israel last week and that its actions in slaughtering 1,300 people likely amounted to genocide.

"These acts constitute gross violation of international law, and, in particular, of international criminal law," declared the document, signed by academic figures and legal authorities in Israel and abroad.

"Videos, released mostly by Hamas, posted on social media, document acts of torture, sexual violence, violence towards children and molestation of bodies," the document specified.

"As these widespread, horrendous acts appear to have been carried out with an 'intent to destroy, in whole or in part' a national group – Israelis – a goal explicitly declared by Hamas, they most probably constitute an international crime of genocide, proscribed by the Genocide Convention and the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court," it added.



Israel has one of the world's most modernised armies equipped with a nuclear arsenal. On the other hand, Palestinians, having no real state and regular army, don't have much to defend themselves.



The Israeli Defence Forces (IDF) has nearly 170,000 active military personnel while it lists more than three million males and females available for army service. It's an extraordinary number for an overall population of just 9 million, showing just how heavily militarised Israel has become.

The IDF also boasts a huge budget, with \$20.5 billion available according to 2019 estimates and ranked 15th in terms of military expenditure globally.

On the other hand, without any real state or regular army, different Palestinian resistance groups have much less manpower than the Israeli army, amounting to circa 30,000 to 50,000 in troops.

According to different estimates, Hamas has between 10,000-20,000 fighters. In 2009, the International Crisis Group estimated the strength of the Qassam Brigades, Hamas' armed wing, as between 7,000 and 10,000. But most recent estimates say the group's manpower could be as high as nearly 40,000. Islamic Jihad, another armed group backed by Iran, has fighters in the region of between 8,000-9,000.

'Top secret' Hamas documents show that terrorists intentionally targeted elementary schools and a youth center

Documents obtained by NBC News show that Hamas created detailed plans to target elementary schools and a youth center in the Israeli kibbutz of Kfar Sa'ad, to "kill as many people as possible," seize hostages and quickly move them into the Gaza Strip. The attack plans, which are labeled "top secret" in Arabic, appear to be orders for two highly trained Hamas units to surround and infiltrate villages and target places where civilians, including children, gather. The documents were found on the bodies of Hamas terrorists by Israeli first responders. They include detailed maps and show that Hamas intended to kill or take hostage civilians and school children.

Pakistani envoy Zaman Mehdi calls the motion on behalf of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation member states, representing 57 countries.

Israel's reservists drop everything and rush home

Some were on their honeymoon, others were studying abroad, many were building new lives in foreign countries. But when Israel called up its reservists and declared war this week, the response was swift and overwhelming. "Everyone is coming. No one is saying no," said Yonatan Steiner, 24, who flew back from New York, where he works for a tech company, to join his old army medical unit. Israel has called up 360,000 reservists in the wake of Saturday's assault by hundreds of Hamas gunmen who overran towns, kibbutzes and army bases near the Gaza enclave, killing more than 1,300 civilians and soldiers and wounding over 2,700. The mass mobilization has not only wrecked holidays but also up-ended lives. Oren Saar, 37, runs a food delivery startup in New York City, where he lives with his wife and three young boys. A former captain in the Israeli army, he immediately acknowledged the call-up, but didn't tell his children what he was doing. "The kids are very young and it's not really something that you want to explain. We told them I'm going on a business trip to Israel," he said, adding that it was going to be "tricky" to keep his new business going in his absence. "But you know, there's just no question about what to do when my friends, my family and my country are at risk," he said.



He paid for 250 tickets.


Could God use me to help deliver His people?
