



Nasrallah praised Hamas' Oct. 7 rampage across southern Israel. The militants attacked farming villages, towns and military posts, killing more than 1,400 people — most of them civilians — and taking hundreds of hostages back to Gaza while Israeli forces were slow to respond. It was "proof that Israel is weaker than a spider's web" and one month into the war, it "has not been able to make any achievement," Nasrallah said. He insisted that Hamas had planned the attack in secrecy and that Hezbollah had no part in it. "This great, large-scale operation was purely the result of Palestinian planning and implementation," Nasrallah said.



In the speech, Nasrallah denied that Hamas had beheaded babies and claimed that there was no evidence to support these accusations. Mocking Israel, the terrorist leader said that in a whole month, Israel had failed to rescue any hostage or make any significant military achievement. The United States is responsible for this war, Nasrallah claimed. He also stated that the current war is a battle between "right and wrong", insisting that Israel's image of being a democratic champion of Human Rights was false.

US special forces said deployed to help Israel track down hostages held in Gaza

Senior Pentagon official says commandos on ground aiding efforts to 'identify hostages, including Americans,' NY Times reports



The US has sent special forces to Israel to assist in finding hundreds of hostages held captive in the Gaza Strip by Hamas, a senior Pentagon official reportedly said Tuesday. Though the US has previously said it has sent military advisers to help Israel in its war on the Hamas terror group, Christopher Maier, an assistant secretary of defense, indicated that commandos have also been deployed, according to the report. "We're actively helping the Israelis to do a number of things," Maier said at a special operations conference in Washington. The comment came a day after Israel freed one of its soldiers who had been held by Gazan terror groups, though it was unclear what role, if any, the American commandos had in the rescue of Pvt. Ori Magidish, one of at least 245 people abducted when thousands of Hamas terrorists invaded southern Israel in a devastating October 7 attack that also killed some 1,400 people. Most of those being held captive are civilians, and several hold US citizenship. Israel has vowed to destroy Hamas and free the hostages, while diplomats from Qatar and other countries have attempted to negotiate their release. Maier, who is the Pentagon's senior special operations policy official, told the conference a key objective for the US personnel is to "identify hostages, including American hostages." "It's really our responsibility to do so," he said. Maier said the US commandos have not been given any combat roles but were discussing with Israeli forces the situation in Gaza for "what is going to be a very complex fight going forward." Though Maier would not reveal how many special operations forces are in Israel the NY Times cited other unnamed US officials as saying several dozen have been sent in the past few days. There was already a small team in Israel on October 7 for previously arranged training. The officials, speaking on condition of anonymity, told the newspaper that the commandos were joining FBI, State Department and other US hostage-recovery specialists who are working with Israeli counterparts. US Defense Secretary Lloyd J. Austin is known to be holding near daily discussions with Israel's Defense Minister Yoav Gallant in which he has reportedly stressed that any ground incursion into Gaza must be carefully handled due to the complexity of fighting in a tightly populated urban area, further complicated by the networks of tunnels Hamas has dug under the Strip to hide and moves its forces. "We will work with them as much as possible to help advise them on those types of activities," Maier said.



A White House official said on Saturday that the evacuation of the wounded and foreign citizens from Gaza was delayed because Hamas had tried to take some of its wounded fighters through the Rafah crossing to Egypt for treatment, Hebrew media sourced the official as saying. "A third of the people who were on the list that Hamas submitted turned out to be Hamas fighters," said the official. The official added that **809**0 the administration is talking about a "humanitarian truce" and not a ceasefire, and claimed that it is impossible to talk about it "when a terrorist organization murders 1,400 people, kidnaps civilians, and hides in tunnels." President Biden's visit to Israel and a conversation with Egyptian President El-Sisi led to the beginning of the arrival of humanitarian aid, about 100 trucks a day, N12 reported, and he says that "they are working on it to increase." The conversation with the Egyptian president acknowledged that there are still foreign citizens in Gaza who have difficulty leaving the region. "Yesterday foreign nationals were allowed to leave Gaza but Hamas didn't allow them. There are approximately 6,000 foreign nationals and 1,000 Americans and their families who cannot leave because of Hamas," N12 reported him as saying.

California university offers extra credit for marching against Israel

Controversy erupted when a teacher at UC Berkeley offered her students extra credit for participating in anti-Israel activities in support of terrorist-run Gaza.

The University of California Berkeley is under fire after the school approved an instructor's plan to offer extra credit to students who participate in an anti-Israel march or watch an anti-Israel documentary.

Graduate student Victoria Huynh, who is pursuing her Ph.D. in the Department of Ethnic Studies at UC Berkeley, sent an email to students enrolled in her course, "Asian American Communities and Race Relations," about the anti-Israel extracredit options.

The email promoted an event called the "National walkout against genocide, settler-colonialism, and the siege of Gaza," and informed students that they had the option to participate in the national student walkout or watch a short documentary on Palestine and contact their local California representatives.

This participation would count as either a field trip or an extra five points in the field trip category of their course grade.

After students posted a screenshot of the assignment on social media, the school faced heavy backlash, including with a diversity and inclusion organization that Huynh had previously worked for, Model Expand.

The post about the assignment received more than 1.9 million views in less than a day.

UC Berkeley received extensive criticism on social media, with concerns raised about the safety of Jewish students on campus and the broader implications of such actions by a teacher.

After dozens of media outlets contacted UC Berkeley over the issue, a spokesperson there responded that they are broadening the scope of the assignment.

In an official statement, the university explained that students could now attend any local event related to the course's subject, including protests, panel discussions, or book talks.

They could also watch any documentary related to the Middle East, not just those with an anti-Israel focus.

UC Berkeley's Assistant Vice Chancellor at the Office of Communications and Public Affairs, Dan Mogulof, said in a statement: "The situation has been remedied, the assignment has been changed, and there are now a number of options for extra credit, not just one."

The teacher's email also drew condemnation from pro-Israel activists who called it indoctrination.

"Extra credit for protesting anything is pathetic," Matt Sarelson, a Florida-based attorney, wrote in a post on X viewed more than 10,000 times. "Extra credit for participating in a pro-Hamas protest is evil."

Israeli forces hit an ambulance that was in control and use of Hamas terrorists, the IDF said on Friday evening. 





Israel's Shin Bet released footage on Wednesday of a Hamas terrorist describing his actions in the south of Israel during the October 7 massacre. "The mission was simply to kill," said Hamas operative Omar Abu Rusha. "We weren't supposed to kidnap. Just kill." He specified: "[We were told] to kill every person we see and come back." The interviewer asked if he was told to make any distinction between men, women, and children. He said he was not. Abu Rusha was then asked what the goal of the attack was and why he was instructed to kill indiscriminately. "They told us that all the settlers were soldiers, there were soldiers. Kill every single one you see. "His superiors told him that even the women were soldiers. "They told you to kill everyone? The women and the children?" asked the interviewer. "Yes." Abu Rusha was among the terrorists who pillaged Kibbutz Kfar Azza. "We got to Kfar Azza. We were inside a jeep. [Our guide] opened the fence on the border of Kfar Azza using an explosive device." "We went to the first house. There was nobody there. Hamzeh A-Zarad burned the exterior room. Afterwards, someone came out towards the garden in the back with a water hose. [Members of our team] saw him, shot him, and killed him. That's the first thing that happened." "Afterward, we went to the second house. We fired at the windows and broke all the glass. We got to the house, checked it, didn't find any people inside. I set fire to the bedroom." "We went to the third house. There was a woman inside. Hamzeh killed her. He shot her." Abu Rusha reported that his team examined another empty house and moved onto a fifth, which they stayed in for about ninety minutes. "Then three settlers came in our direction," he said. There was an exchange of fire during which Abu Rusha killed one person and his comrades threw grenades. "After that, the shooting stopped." They they went out into the orchards and hid in the trees for nearly two hours. They entered another house through the window. "We checked the house and heard the sounds of young children in the safe room. We shot at the safe room." He said that he and his comrades kept shooting until they heard no more noise. Soon afterward, they surrendered and turned themselves in. Following Abu Rusha's account, the interviewer asked: "Is killing children permitted in Islam?" "No," he replied.

"Israel is a country that has no place on our land," Hamas official Ghazi Hamad told Lebanese news outlet LBCI news this week, according to a report and translation from the Middle East Media Research Institute released on Wednesday. "We must remove that country," he continued. "We must teach Israel a lesson, and we will do this again and again. The Al-Aqsa Flood is just the first time, and there will be a second, a third, a fourth. Because we have the determination...to fight." Hamad continued, talking about the civilian price of the attack that has been paid on both sides of the war. He expressed that the killings at the Re'im music festival were the result of "complications on the ground." "Will we have to pay a price? Yes, and we are ready to pay it. We are called a nation of martyr and we are proud to sacrifice martyrs." He also said: "The existence of Israel is what causes all that pain, blood, and tears. It's Israel, not us. We are the victims of the occupation. Full stop. "Nobody should blame us. On October 7, October 10, October one million - everything we do is justified." Last week, Hamad stormed out of an interview with the BBC after he was asked about the terrorist group's massacre of civilians in Israel on October 7. During the interview, Hamad reiterated claims made starting a few days after the massacre that Hamas did not intend to kill any civilians during its assault.



New websites show firsthand tragic accounts of October 7 massacre

Since the horrific events of October 7, several websites have been built to consolidate information and educate the global population on the details of Hamas's brutal attack. Israel's official X account recently shared www.hamas-massacre.net, a site with dozens of gruesome photos and videos of the slaughter. The site itself appears to still be under construction but can be navigated effectively. Users can see testimony from social media, showing the carnage left in the wake of the Nova Festival ("The Nova Party Massacre") and the invasions into kibbutzim ("Murdered in Their Home"). They can also see videos of Israelis being taken to Gaza as hostages ("Abduction to Gaza") and footage of Gazan rocket fire striking civilian targets ("Rockets Striking Civilians").

Another site, www.october7.org, is focused on the firsthand testimony of the survivors. Entitled "Eyewitness stories from inside the massacre," the site aims to "[stand] as a testament to the unwavering spirit of the survivors who [bore] witness to the unspeakable terrors of October 7th, horrors that continue to haunt the hearts and minds of countless souls across the land of Israel." The site was built by Israeli volunteers who felt moved to create a universally accessible database of the memories of October 7. As of Friday, the site has 118 stories which its creators say are "authentic and unedited." They are in English and some are translated into Spanish and French. Some are from the Nova Festival, others are from residents of the kibbutzim that were pillaged. Yael, the only lookout soldier stationed at Nachal Oz who survived the massacre, also posted her story there. The stories, according to the site's own warning, describe "war crimes involving violence, rape, and brutality."

The interactive site www.oct7map.com, in which users can see a visual representation of each murdered and kidnapped person from October 7 accompanied by an explanation of the day's events. Per the website's own explanation, visitors are encouraged use it to "visit the different sites, listen to the facts, and witness the horrors." Users can flip through different parts of the interactive map, beginning with Re'im, moving onto Be'eri, Kfar Aza, Netiv HaAssara, Ofakim, Nir Oz, Nirim, Sderot, the Re'im army base, the Nahal Oz army base, and finally the hostage situation in Be'eri. At each stage, the site zooms in on the relevant place on the map which is littered with red dots signifying murders. Some also have black dots signifying those who were kidnapped and grey for missing or injured. Each dot has a name next to it. There is also a short explanation on the side of the page for each event and a tally of the total murdered, kidnapped, missing, and injured. oct7map.com uses several sources to piece together its information, including october7.org, AP News, the National Review, Reuters, Wikipedia, Times of Israel, and ZAKA Search and Rescue. All of these websites continue to add information daily as more people come forward with testimony and more information comes out about the whereabouts of still-missing people.
