What constitutes a "household"?

- Individuals
- Married couples
- Married couples with children
- Multi-generational families



Do not be envious of evil men, nor desire to be with them; for their minds devise violence, and their lips talk of trouble. Proverbs 24:1-2



Who are the role models for my family? What is considered "family success" today?

- Do not envy a man of violence and do not choose any of his ways. Proverbs 3:31
- Do not let your heart envy sinners, but live in the fear of the Lord always. Proverbs 23:17
- Do not fret because of evildoers or be envious of the wicked; for there will be no future for the evil man; the lamp of the wicked will be put out. Proverbs 24:19-20

Do not fret because of evildoers, be not envious toward wrongdoers. For they will wither quickly like the grass and fade like the green herb. Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and cultivate faithfulness. Delight yourself in the Lord; and He will give you the desires of your heart. Wisdom and Understanding

- In the Bible, understanding is the ability to grasp the meaning and implications of facts and God's truth, while wisdom is the skill to apply that understanding to life's circumstances, knowing what to do and how to live righteously.
- Understanding is like getting the facts and seeing the picture clearly, whereas wisdom is using that clear vision to make correct decisions and take appropriate actions.
- Both are gifts from God and are necessary for godly living.

How to Live This Principle

1. Renew your mind

2. Be Christ-like

3. Be discerning

• Be aware of how cultural norms might interfere with your Christian walk, especially the underlying beliefs and assumptions.

Building spiritual "muscles" in the family

- Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Building a God-honoring household today requires fighting against the values of the culture

Blessed be the Lord, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle; my lovingkindness and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield and He in whom I take refuge, Who subdues my people under me. Psalm 144:1-2

Building a God-honoring household today requires fighting against the values of the culture BUT NOT ABANDONING THE CULTURE

- Jesus prayed, "I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world." John 17:15-18
- To raise God-honoring children, parents who love Jesus must model lives that follow and reflect Jesus IN THE WORLD while not being CONFORMED TO THE WORLD

Preparing for spiritual warfare

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand firm therefore, having girded your loins with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6:10-18

Be prepared to fight spiritual battles with a spiritual army around you



Wisdom is too exalted for a fool, he does not open his mouth in the gate. Proverbs 24:7



Proverbs 24:7 means that true wisdom is beyond the comprehension of a "fool," not in terms of intellect, but in terms of his ungodly attitude, arrogance, and stubbornness. A fool, characterized by his lack of humility and his focus on his own desires, cannot grasp the profound truths of divine wisdom.

The phrase "in the gate" refers to the ancient public square where city matters were discussed, and a fool's inability to contribute wisely there shows his inherent limitations when it comes to genuine insight and judgment.

Listen, learn, and speak truth



One who plans to do evil, men will call a schemer. The devising of folly is sin, and the scoffer is an abomination to men. Proverbs 24:8-9



What are my goals for my family?

"Surely I will not enter my house, nor lie on my bed; I will not give sleep to my eyes or slumber to my eyelids, until I find a place for the Lord, a dwelling place for the Mighty One of Jacob." Psalm 132:3-5
