Scripture Reference: Exodus 14-15

Connection:

- What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- What are you excited for this summer?

Reflection:

- Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?

Application

1. **Read Exodus 14:10-12.** What motivated this response by Israel to Moses and to God? Can you identify with these voices? Have you questioned a miracle or some answer God has given to you? If so, what did you learn from that experience about trusting Him more.
2. **Read Exodus 14:13-14.** What is the significance of Moses' response to Israel here? What does it mean for the Lord to fight for us while we keep silent?
3. **Read Psalm 77:16-20.** What do you learn about the crossing of the sea from this passage?
4. **Read Exodus 15.** What stands out to you about how Israel praised God in this song?
5. How do you tend to praise God? What are your habits in prayer to express praise and worship to Him?
6. End by praying together for our church to trust God more and to be more dependent upon Him.
