Connection:

- 1. **Read Exodus 14:10-12.** What motivated this response by Israel to Moses and to God? Can you identify with these voices? Have you questioned a miracle or some answer God has given to you? If so, what did you learn from that experience about trusting Him more.
- 2. **Read Exodus 14:13-14.** What is the significance of Moses' response to Israel here? What does it mean for the Lord to fight for us while we keep silent?
- 3. **Read Psalm 77:16-20.** What do you learn about the crossing of the sea from this passage?
- 4. **Read Exodus 15.** What stands out to you about how Israel praised God in this song?
- 5. How do you tend to praise God? What are your habits in prayer to express praise and worship to Him?
- 6. End by praying together for our church to trust God more and to be more dependent upon Him.
