Connection:

Application:

- 3. What do you learn about the character of Moses in chapters 32-34? What virtues does he demonstrate?
- 4. Are there times you have pleaded with God for someone or some group that was not walking in faith? What were those prayers of pleading like?
- 5. Read Exodus 32:7-14. Why does God show mercy to Israel? What does that mean for us today?
- 6. When has God shown mercy to you? What did you learn from that time in your life?

7.	End by praying together for our church to trust God more and resist idols, and pray for our pastors and elders to always follow the Lord's path.
