



Sermon Title: Unstoppable: Doubting Thomas

Scripture Reference: John 20:24-31

Connection:

- What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- What is most exciting coming up this springtime?

Reflection:

- Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?

Application:

1. Thomas refused to believe without evidence, yet Jesus met him in his skepticism. How have doubts or questions ever moved you closer to faith rather than farther away?
2. The disciples were in a locked room full of fear and uncertainty, yet Jesus showed up and spoke peace. Where in your life do you need Jesus to show up in the middle of doubt or fear right now?

Additional Reading: John 14:27; Psalm 34:4; Isaiah 26:3

3. Thomas declared, "My Lord and my God!" after encountering Jesus. What helped you personally move from knowing about Jesus to believing in Him? What helped that shift happen?

Additional Reading: Matthew 16:15-17; Romans 10:9-10; John 1:12

4. Jesus says, "Blessed are those who believe without seeing." What makes belief difficult in today's culture? What helps strengthen belief even when you can't see?

Additional Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:7; Hebrews 11:1; 1 Peter 1:8-9

5. The sermon emphasized that God has already given us everything we need to believe. What evidence for Jesus has been most meaningful in your life? Scripture, personal experience, changed lives, history, or something else?
