Connection:

Reflection:

Application

1. Share about a person who intentionally invested in your faith journey. How did it have an impact?
2. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Psalm 78:1-8. What do these passages teach about passing faith to the next generation? Who is younger than you that you are intentionally investing in right now?
3. Paul tells Timothy to "fan into flame" the gift God placed in him. What are some things that help stir your faith up? What are things that cause your faith to cool down?
4. Read 2 Timothy 2:1-7 and Titus 2:1-8. What patterns do you see for intentionally passing faith to others?
5. Timothy struggled with fear and timidity. What fears often keep you from stepping out in faith?
6. Read Acts 4:23-31. What do these verses teach about the Spirit's role in empowering and shaping believers? Share about a time when God helped you do something you didn't feel capable of doing on your own?
