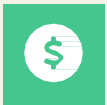

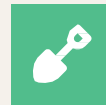
## EXPERIENCES

## SEMINARS

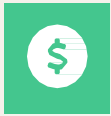

# Payment Policy

You are officially registered for LIFE when you sign up online and submit your \$150 non-refundable deposit. At this point, you have committed to pay for the entire cost of the trip, as we have many costs that we pay before the money due dates we give you. **The final deadline to be paid in full is May 25, 2025.**

The deadlines listed on the payment schedule on page 9 will help you/your student budget. The CCC IMPACT Ministry team will check payments after each deadline. If you aren't able to make a payment, please contact the CCC IMPACT Ministry team.

Remaining payments can be made online or by check or cash. Checks should be made out to CCC with "LIFE 2025" and your students name in the memo line.

The week of October 28<sup>th</sup>, all who are registered at that time will receive a link to use for proceeding payments.

## Donation Information

All LIFE payments are considered donations and are tax-deductible to the donor, even if that person is a parent of a student or an attendee themselves. Tax deductibility does not apply to any personal expenses the attendees may incur, including any recreational or personal expenses while on the trip.
