Sermon: How to Pray for Your Finances

Prayer is communication based on a relationship with a God who loves you more than you will ever know.

So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:31-33

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19

3 Truths about Praying for Provision:

- God may provide differently than you expect
- God provides more of Himself
- You come to know that God's ultimate provision has already been given to you in the Gospel

Pray this promise found in Philippians 4:4-7

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

When you pray for provision, you can expect:

- The promise of daily bread
- Holy Spirit to give you counsel
- Peace and rest

A Prayer for Provision:

“Lord, I thank you for who you are as my Father, my Lord, and my Provider. You are faithful to who you are and to all you say. I, gratefully, acknowledge your faithful provision in my life. Jesus, I remember how you’ve provided for me in times past in _____.

(Verbalize your recollections of how God has provided for you in both the past and present.)

Now, Lord, I ask you to meet my need for _____.

Lord, you said in Philippians 4:19, and I pray Your Word back to you knowing I’m in agreement with Your will as I pray... “And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.”

Thank You, Jesus, for being my provider.
