

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how Copperfield Church (“we,” “us”) collects, uses, and shares personal information about you and explains how you can exercise your privacy rights. We respect your privacy. This Privacy Policy applies to visitors to and users of this website and any other website maintained by us (collectively, our “Sites”), visitors to our office, congregants and worshipers, job applicants, third-party service providers, vendors and suppliers, and users of our mobile application (“App”).

If you provide personal information to us about any person other than yourself, it is your responsibility to ensure that the other person understands how such information will be used, including the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, before it is provided to us. If you provide us with such information, we are entitled to, and will, assume without confirmation that you have obtained such consent. By accessing or using our Sites or App, you signify that you have read, understood, and agree to our collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Information that You Provide Voluntarily. We collect certain personal information from you when you choose to provide us with this information through contacting or communicating with us, attending the church on its property, using our Sites, or using our App. This personal information may include, without limitation, your first and last name, address, email address, phone number, video and photographic images of you, dates and times of your visit or use, and voiceprints, as applicable.

Information We Receive from Other Parties. From time to time, we may receive information about you from persons other than you including, without limitation, our customers, other users of our Sites or App, investors, data service providers, vendors, and suppliers. This information may include information required to process payments, such as tax ID numbers and wire instruction details. We may combine this information with other information we collect from or about you. In these cases, this Privacy Policy governs the handling of the combined information. We may also collect information about you that is publicly available.

Employment Information. When you apply for a job with us, we may receive information such as your name, address, email address, telephone number, current and post employers, job titles, and other personal information you include in application documents, such as your resume.

Information that We Collect Automatically. Our Sites and our App may collect certain information automatically from your device when you use it, such as information about the device or browser from which you are accessing our Sites or the App or diagnostic data. In

some countries, including countries in the European Economic Area ("EEA"), this information may be considered personal information under applicable data protection laws.

Our Sites and our App may also collect information about how your device has interacted with the Sites or our App, including the pages accessed and links clicked. Embedded Content from Other Websites

Our Sites and our App may include embedded content (e.g., videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use and process or share your personal information (1) to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations, (2) because we need the information for reasons of substantial public interests, (3) to comply with our obligations under contract, (4) because we have a legitimate pastoral, congregational, or spiritual interest in using it, (5) as otherwise permitted by law, or (6) for any other purposes we may describe when you provide the information, including, for example, the following purposes, as applicable:

- To respond to your questions and handle and resolve requests for pastoral or other service;
- To maintain and provide appropriate management of our relationship with you;
- To communicate with you about our church, services, community news, promotions, or events we think may be of interest to you, as well as send you surveys and similar materials;
- To set up meetings or phone calls between you and our church leaders;
- To perform research with respect to the usage of the Sites or the App and to operate, maintain, and provide the features and functionalities for them, including providing customer support and analytics from the Sites or the App or diagnosing or fixing technology problems;
- To cooperate with law enforcement agencies, courts, and/or government authorities in accordance with our legal obligations under applicable laws, as necessary;
- To understand our visitors and customers, to tailor our interactions and communication, to analyze statistics and trends to make our products, Sites, and App better, and to develop new services or features;

- to maintain the security of our premises, personnel, assets, and systems and to manage access to our premises and our disaster recovery procedures;
- To comply with our obligations in connection with record-keeping and accounting requirements; and
- To facilitate the relationship between us third party service providers and vendors (for example, Pushpay) who provide services to us, including data processing services.

We do not sell your information or share it for the purposes of targeted marketing. We may share information with others in an aggregated or otherwise anonymized form that does not reasonably identify you directly as an individual.

DATA SECURITY

We use appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect the personal information that we collect about you. Please be advised, however, that while we deploy these security measures and strive to protect your personal data, the use of the internet is not 100% secure, and for this reason we cannot guarantee the security or integrity of any personal data that you transmit or disclose to us online.

We retain your personal information for as long as we require it for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. However, we may also keep some of your personal information for a specified period of time as required by certain laws (for example to comply with applicable legal, tax or accounting requirements).
