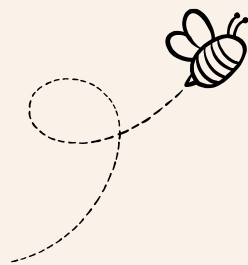

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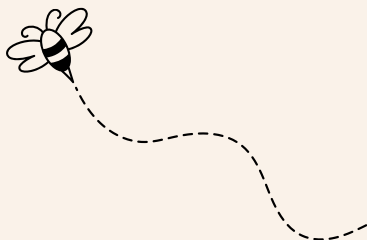
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OUR HEART



Welcome ladies to our 2025 Mother Daughter Retreat. We are so excited to have you here this weekend.

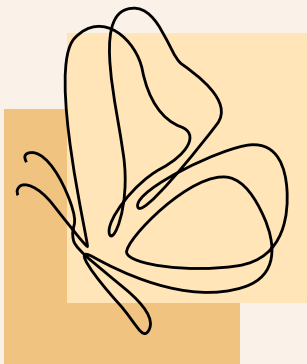
We have been praying for each of you ladies. We are praying that you connect deeper with the Lord during this time and take this time to grow in your relationship with your family.

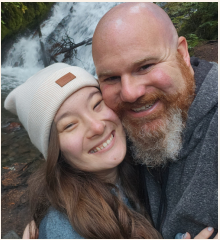

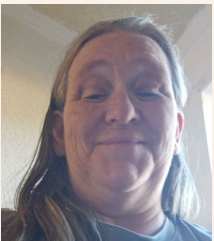

Thank you for being here. Thank you for taking the time to come and enjoy fellowship with your daughter/mom and all the other amazing women here. Throughout this weekend we will be diving into the way we view each other and especially the way we view ourselves. At times this may feel hard. It may be emotional and you may find old ways of thinking hard to let go of. It's ok. We are all on this amazing journey with the Lord together. A journey is not an arrival, but a going towards. As Paul said, "Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me." Take a moment to appreciate where you currently are in your journey. You are here! You are an amazing, uniquely created human being that your Creator is thrilled about! Let that sink in for a moment.... Your creator (Your Papa) rejoices in you. YOU!

There may be things that you hear that seem hard to believe about yourself and who the Lord created you to be. I want you to know that **your belief about you has no bearing on what the Lord knows to be TRUE about you.** Likely you have been believing many things about yourself that are completely false. Take some time tonight to go to scripture and find out what your creator says is true about you. Here are just a few starting points

Whole (Col 2:10)

Blameless (1:22)

Friend (John 15:11-17)

Light (John 8:12, Ephesians 5:8)

Perfect (Matthew 5:48, Col 1:28)

Heir to the Kingdom (Romans 8:14, Galatians 4:6-7)

Glorious (Romans 8:18-19)

Mighty (Ephesians 6:10)

Hope of Glory (Colossians 1:26-27)

Righteous (Romans 6:18)

After this time: Go to the Lord in conversation (together or separately). Ask the Lord to give you a vision of how He sees you. Write down what you see. Don't be shy about it. Your Papa loves you so much! Stay saturated in Love and Truth as you write.

What a beautiful day to walk in the Kingdom! Did you know that our life is not intended to be a test? We aren't intended to "try" or to "strive". We were created to rest in Him.

Did you rest last night? Are you resting now? Think back about what the Lord spoke to you last night. Your loving Papa's Joy is for you to Rest in Him and enjoy the creation He gave you while walking in your true identity. When we realize our true identity, we are transformed, in our speech, our actions, our conversations and relationships. No longer do we see ourselves from the false, we instead walk wholly in truth! Our perspective is so important! How might your day be different today by walking in your true identity? Write down a few things that come to your mind. Think/meditate. If you can, take a moment to walk with the Lord and talk with Him. Ask him how your relationship with your daughter/mom might be transformed by this new walk. As you do, no doubt you will be filled with JOY! These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. (John 15:11)

Walk in expectation of great new things today. Be open to laying aside old thinking and embracing your true identity.

Prayers for my mother/daughter



Take a moment to reflect on the day... Was it different than you expected? Did you walk in Joy and Love? How did you walk in your true identity today? Did you find yourself still holding on to old ways of thinking? That's ok! That is part of the beautiful journey we are on, but as you learn to take your thoughts captive and bring them into truth, it will get easier and easier for you. You have been walking in the false for a long time, it has become a habit. You likely won't be able to change that overnight! Transformation is a process! Renewing your mind is a continual process. However, dream for a moment.... What would it look like to be truly free? To take every thought captive and truly walk in truth all the time? Wow!

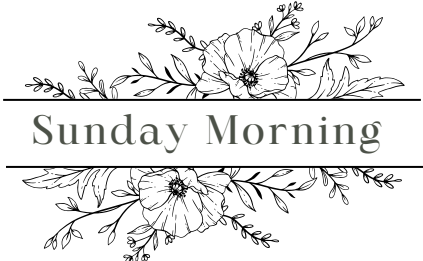
As Jesus said: And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. How does this feel? What would be different about you if you only walked in truth? If you embraced who you were created to be and fully walked in it, no longer walking in the lies, fully taking those thoughts captive and staying saturated in truth? We all have very unique gifts (parts of the Lord's character) in us.

Have you ever asked the Lord what He calls you? As you are on this journey of transformation, take some time to ask the Lord what he uniquely calls you. Take the time to go to the Lord and ask the question, "Who did you create me to be?" Write down the answers you here. Your creator is living in you! You are the vessel in which Christ dwells! When you here the answer (when going to Him with sincere questions) trust the answers you here. Keep a couple of things in mind... your loving Papa is never condemning, never shaming, and never guilt producing....
