THE GATHERING OF GOD’S PEOPLE

PERSONAL WORSHIP REFLECTION

Corporate worship serves as a spiritual conversation between our heavenly Lord and us. James reminds us of what is supposed to happen when we gather for worship: “Draw near to God and He will draw near to you” (4:8 ESV). This dialogical framework permeates our worship services: God speaks to us and we respond to Him. Let us prepare our hearts to meet with the One Who delights to be called our friend. John Owen offers this simple prayer to guide us: “Christ is our best friend now, and, before long, He will be our only friend. . . . Therefore, I pray to God with all my heart that I may be weary of everything else but to converse and commune with Him.”
