<u>Position Summary:</u> This role will provide collaborative leadership support for the College Ministry Director, focus on overseeing and developing Family Dinners, pursue meaningful connection with newcomers and continue to develop the ministry in alignment with God's leading.

Position Responsibilities:

- Directly oversee and facilitate bi-monthly Family Dinners
 - Lead the Family Dinner volunteer team and recruit leaders as needed
 - Prepare to teach Scripture regularly for Family Dinner
 - Oversee the planning and preparation of activities and content that align with the vision of Family Dinners, collaborating with the College Ministry Director and relevant volunteers
 - Attend Family Dinners and provide feedback to continually develop Family Dinner culture and community
 - Proactively welcome and pursue newcomers, and create a hospitable environment
 - Serve as the main communication channel with hosts
 - Manage inviting and scheduling hosts in advance for upcoming Family Dinners
 - Implement initiatives to connect relationally with hosts and appreciate them

 - Alternate leading the SLT meetings every month with the College Ministry Director
- Assist ProvCollege Director in planning and facilitating occasional events
- Provide collaborative planning and leadership for the fall retreat
- Meet biweekly with College Ministry Director
