Position Summary

This key leadership role supports Providence Coatesville's mission by shepherding the worship life of the church and helping create Christ-centered, Spirit-led Sunday gatherings. The Worship Lead works closely with the Lead Pastor to plan, prepare, and lead engaging corporate worship that aligns with the church's doctrine, mission, vision, and values. They equip, mentor, and develop a team of musicians and vocalists, cultivating a culture of excellence and participation that invites the congregation to exalt Christ together. Strong musical ability, leadership, and relational investment are essential, along with a heart for serving the local church and the community we are called to love.

Responsibilities:

1. Lead congregational worship during Sunday PM or AM services.
2. Skillfully play the piano or guitar and lead vocals, creating a dynamic and engaging atmosphere for worship.
3. Select and prepare worship songs that align with the church's theological beliefs and resonate with the congregation.
4. Collaborate with the pastoral team to creatively integrate worship sets into the sermon series and overall worship experience.
5. Foster a worship environment that encourages congregational participation.
6. Recruit, train, and lead a team of musicians and vocalists for the worship ministry.
7. Provide mentorship and guidance to team members, helping develop their musical and spiritual gifts.
8. Participate in planning and coordinating special worship events and services.

9. Cultivate a culture of worship that aligns with the church's doctrine, mission, vision and values.
10. Maintain open communication with the pastoral team and congregation regarding worship-related matters.

Qualifications:

1. Proficient in playing the piano or guitar and strong vocal abilities.
2. Demonstrated experience leading worship in diverse settings.
3. Strong personal commitment to Jesus Christ.
4. Ability to teach and train worship team members effectively.
5. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
6. Experience with sound equipment and technology used in worship settings is a plus.
7. Willingness to invest relationally into the life of the Providence Church Family and Coatesville community.
