A few additional things to consider when choosing a class for next year:

-We generally follow the SUSD calendar for major holidays and vacation time. There are many Monday holidays throughout the school year. Please keep this in mind when looking at our MWF class options.

-Our tuition is based on the cost of an entire school year, but we divide this amount into ten equal monthly payments (billed August through May). We do not prorate tuition due to illness, months where we have holiday breaks or when there are other days away from school.

-Our Early Bird and Lunch Bunch programs do not begin until early October, and there are other times during the school year when they may not be offered (before holiday breaks and the last two weeks of school). Our Early Bird and Lunch Bunch programs conclude in April. Lunch Bunch is never offered on Tuesdays or Fridays.

-We encourage families to choose the older MWF class, 4 Day or 5 Day as a final year of preschool before kindergarten. In Arizona's public schools, children must be 5 by September 1st to begin the kindergarten year.

-We group students in classrooms based on a child's age on September 1st. We cannot guarantee a classroom based on teacher preference, but we'll happily take your request. If we're able to fulfill a teacher request, we will. Feel free to leave us a note anywhere on your registration form. Please note that we have two sections of our 4 Day Class.

-We are unable to accommodate special requests from families to mix and match class days or double up on classrooms to create a full week of school.
