

Funds of Valley Presbyterian Foundation

- 1. <u>Scholarship Funds</u> donates scholarship assistance for students from our church families.
- Children & Youth Education Funds expands church youth programs beyond the annual budget.
- 3. <u>Boy Scouts Troop 441 Fund</u> supports furthering character development, citizenship training and mental and physical skills of the individual members of the Troop founded at VPC.
- 4. <u>Music Funds</u> gives financial support for the various music programs of Valley Presbyterian Church, which has had a long legacy of excellence in music.
- 5. **Annis Organ Fund** provides for restoration and maintenance of the sanctuary organ.
- 6. Stephen Ministry Fund provides for training and education of Valley Stephen leaders.
- 7. <u>Deacon Ministry Fund</u> supplements Deacon Committee funding for specific use in congregational care.
- 8. **Garvin Mission Fund** provides financial support for mission trips led by VPC outreach.
- 9. <u>First Fruits Fund</u> ministers to those who want to learn and practice economic gardening, inspired by Field of Dreams gardening program during the 2010-11 Season of Service.
- 10. **Preservation Fund** assists in preservation and maintenance of VPC campus to preserve the architectural character and sustain safe and durable place for ministry.
- 11. <u>Memorial Garden Fund</u> finances continuing maintenance and repair of the Memorial Garden and support needed improvements or modifications to the garden.
- 12. <u>General Endowment Fund</u> offers supplemental support for undesignated capital and mission needs of VPC.
