SPARKS IN MARCH!

(To Energize Your Journey To Easter)

Five Spiritual Sparks That Could Ignite A Fresh Fire In Your Heart This Easter Season!

A Spark is a flicker or a trigger that starts small that can lead to something big.

To Ignite means to catch fire, arouse, inflame, to heat up, to burn, to excite.

To Reignite means to begin or cause something to burn again, to give new life or energy to something.

Fire in God's Word is symbolic of the manifest presence of God.

The Word "FIRE" appears 474 times throughout God's Word from Genesis to Revelation.

- RECHARGE!

To regain energy or spirit.

³⁰ The apostles returned to Jesus and told him all that they had done and taught. ³¹ And he said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. *Mark 6:30-31, ESV*

- REMEMBRANCE!

The act of remembering and showing respect for someone who has died or for a past event.

¹⁹ And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁰ And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood. *Luke 22:19-20, ESV*

- REPENTANCE!

It involves conviction of sin, contrition over offenses, turning away from sin, turning toward God.

¹⁴ Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, ¹⁵ and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." *Mark 1:14-15, ESV*

- RECONCILIATION!

The restoration of a relationship to a harmonious state after a dispute.

¹⁵ "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. ¹⁶ But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses.

Matthew 18:15-16, ESV

- REVERENCE!

To honor and show respect that is deeply felt and outwardly demonstrated.

⁴ "I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do. ⁵ But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him! *Luke 12:4-5, ESV*
