BIBLICAL ELDERSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

FINAL CHURCH CONSTITUTION REVIEW THIS EVENING, MARCH 26TH, AT 6 PM IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL

In 2022 our church family voted to continue moving towards a goal of governance by Biblical Eldership (BE). The BE team has spent much of the last year working out what eldership should look like practically for New Life Church. This includes redistributing some church responsibilities from the pastor and deacons to the elders and establishing conditions for serving as an elder. The BE team recognizes that such a model of church leadership will require a number of changes to the church's constitution. To this end, the BE team completed a review of the church constitution, and we would now like to share those changes with you. We will be distributing copies of the revised draft of the constitution during the week of February 26th.

The BE team has set aside two Sunday evenings in March for the church to come together to review the proposed changes to the constitution. We will present the changes and allow time for questions and discussion. The first meeting will be on March 12th at 6 PM, and the second meeting will be on March 26th at 6 PM. Both meetings will be held in the Fellowship Hall and will be identical in format and content. The gym will be open for ages 2 yrs. through youth and will be supervised during these times. The nursery will not be staffed. Please plan to come out to one of these meetings.

In April, the church will be given the opportunity to vote to confirm the constitutional changes. A church business meeting is scheduled for Sunday April 23rd. The meeting will take place immediately following the Sunday morning worship service.

The BE team is thankful for your continued prayers through this transitional period. Do not hesitate to reach out to us if you have any questions or concerns regarding these specific changes or BE in general.

For a fire to be kept burning it needs oxygen and fuel.

In the same way, for our spiritual lives to remain burning we need the breath of the Spirit and the regular addition of fuel in the form of prayer and Scripture.

- Noon: Set an alarm in the middle of the day and choose to stop and pray the Lord's Prayer!
- **Night:** Finish the day by thanking God for the blessings of the day, acknowledging the challenges, and asking Him for strength, perspective, forgiveness, peace and rest!
