THE SEVEN LAST SAYINGS OF JESUS!

1. The Word Of Forgiveness - *Luke 23:34, NKJV*

³⁴ Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

2. The Word Of Salvation - *Luke 23:43, NKJV*

⁴³ And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

3. The Word Of Love - *John 19:25-27, NKJV*

²⁵ Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. ²⁶ When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing by, He said to His mother, "Woman, behold your son!" ²⁷ Then He said to the disciple, "Behold your mother!" And from that hour that disciple took her to his own *home*.

4. The Word Of Abandonment - *Matthew 27:45-46, NKJV*

⁴⁵ Now from the sixth hour until the ninth hour there was darkness over all the land. ⁴⁶ And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

5. The Word Of Suffering - *John 19:28, NKJV*

²⁸ After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"

6. The Word Of Victory - *John 19:30, NKJV*

³⁰ So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

7. The Word Of Confidence - *Luke 23:46, NKJV*

⁴⁶ And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, 'into Your hands I commit My spirit.' " Having said this, He breathed His last.
