After having seen two vibrant, soulwinning churches established in the suburbs of Mexico City with trained pastors and their own properties paid for, in 2004 our family moved into Mexico City itself just across the freeway from Mexico's largest military base and Army and Air Force headquarters. As a former Marine, God has given me a love for military families and led us to this area of Mexico City to see Mexican soldiers and airmen reached and strengthened spiritually for Christ.

We have a unique ministry as we have had members from most every continent as we are in the zone of many embassies. We have even had some of the thousands of Jews thrive in the neighborhoods around us attend our church as we have an outreach to the Jews passing out gospel tracts in their neighborhood every Tuesday Evening.

Our ministries are now comprised of a Bible Institute, a Christian school, and two missions pastored by our institute graduates with the plans to see them developed into independent churches beginning next year. We also have an RU addictions program both in our church and in a street mission we started in the inner city.

Our future plans are to turn the church over to a national pastor in five years and found a Bible college and seminary as a ministry of the church and help graduates of the college evangelize and establish other churches in Mexico City.

How To Pray For Prodigals!
Psalm 51:1-19,NKJV
Message 2 - "It Starts With Us!"

Three Life-Changing Prayers

1. David asked God to cleanse him - Psalm 51:1-7, NKJV

51 Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness; According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, Blot out my transgressions. ² Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, And cleanse me from my sin.

⇒ Prayer Point - Pray fervently for God to forgive and cleanse you from any known or unknown sin that could be a stumbling block to cause your children to stumble or stray from God.

³ For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin *is* always before me. ⁴ Against You, You only, have I sinned, And done *this* evil in Your sight—That You may be found just when You speak, *And* blameless when You judge.

⁵ Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me. ⁶ Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, And in the hidden *part* You will make me to know wisdom.

⁷ Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

2. David asked God to restore him - Psalm 51:8-12, NKJV ⁸ Make me hear joy and gladness, *That* the bones You have broken may rejoice. ⁹ Hide Your face from my sins, And blot out all my iniquities. ¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. ¹¹ Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. ¹² Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me *by Your* generous Spirit. ⇒ Prayer Point - Pray fervently for God to restore to you a closeness with Himself and with your children that you once loved and enjoyed. 3. <u>David asked God to use him</u> - *Psalm 51:13-19, NKJV* ¹³ *Then* I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You. ¹⁴ Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, The God of my salvation, *And* my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness. ¹⁵O Lord, open my lips, And my mouth shall show forth Your praise. ¹⁶ For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it. You do not delight in burnt offering. ¹⁷ The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise. ¹⁸ Do good in Your good pleasure to Zion; Build the walls of Jerusalem. ¹⁹ Then You shall be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, With burnt offering and whole burnt offering; Then they shall offer bulls on Your altar. ⇒ Prayer Point - Pray fervently for God to melt you, mold you, fill you and use you to have a
