We will be serving baked goods and treats at 10:30 a.m. Coffee Hour Fellowship in the Connector this week. Here is the schedule for this week:



25th Anniversary of the Bible in a Book Bag Mission!

For 24 consecutive years the WPC congregation has supported the students at the Cornerstone Christian Academy in Philadelphia through the Bible in a Book Bag program. The program is managed by the WPC Deacons and each year supplies over 140 students in grades kindergarten through 8th grade with a bookbag, school supplies and a bible. The 2023-2024 will mark the 25th consecutive year of the program, a remarkable achievement and illustration of the WPC congregation's commitment to the Cornerstone Christian Academy's mission to provide a safe, reliable and faith-based learning environment for our youth in Philadelphia.

Planning and fund-raising activities for the 2023-2024 school year are kicking off now.
