
# THE STAGE HAS BEEN SET and we've got our marching orders for 2024, picking up our CROSS, spiritual progression, better today-than yesterday.

You have invited someone to walk with you, as you follow Jesus. Intentional relationship where you are pouring into another, teaching & modeling the ways of Jesus, and how to center their lives in Him, grow in faith & a deeper life in Christ.

This is achieved once those you've poured into and discipled begin to pour into and disciple others. Multiplying our lives in others. The 2 you poured into, each are pouring into 2 themselves - 2 has multiplied into 6!



### The Cost of Discipleship

Sitting at His feet



### Matthew 4:18-22

### 4:19 "Follow Me, and I will make you... fishers of men."

### Peter, Andrew, James, John FISHERMEN – He saw them.

He does not only see us in our current state, but He sees us where He intends us to be in the Kingdom, using our gifts in the kingdom.

They already HAD THE GIFT in them, they just didn't know the extent of how God planned to use it! "from fishermen to fishers OF MEN!"

### They immediately left their nets & followed Him

Immediate surrender

They left something valuable behind (cost)

Discipleship COSTS you something

At a minimum, you are exchanging your will for His

#### He said to them

"FOLLOW ME" – 1st thing you are called to do, most important,

"And I WILL MAKE YOU" – following Him, changes us into who He is making us into



### Matthew 9:9

### ...and He said to him, "Follow Me." So he arose & followed Him.

## Matthew – A tax collector "He saw him" at the tax office

- -Were hated & criticized by the Jewish society of that time
- They were dishonest and skimmed off the top, charged more than the tax amount and pocketed the extra for themselves

#### **Tax Collectors**

- They're also known to be great record keepers

(the gift was already in him)

He was then able to use that same SKILL/GIFT to pen the Book of Matthew

#### He said to Matthew

"FOLLOW ME" – 1<sup>st</sup> thing you are called to do & most important!

How did Matthew respond?

And He arose and followed him.



### **Matthew 9:10-13**

"10 While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and sinners came and ate with him and his disciples. 11 When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"
12 On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. 13 But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.'
For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Peter – preached the 1st Sermon in the book of ACTS!!! And over 2,000 were saved THAT DAY!! Acts 21:41-47


### 12 Disciples:


