Spiritual Fitness

The Christian lifestyle requires training and discipline, *Not Rules and Regulations*; Jesus died to free us, not bind us in chains

1 Corinthians 6:12 – Paul said,

All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.





How do we stay Spiritually fit?

We get involved in Spiritual Exercises and develop a daily spiritual regimen, such as.

- Prayer.
- Meditation on God.
- Studying the scriptures and applying them to our life.
- * Acts of kindness.
- Forgive and live.
- Surround yourselves with supportive and like-minded individuals.

A pacesetter is a person or entity that sets a pace or standard that others follow.

The idea behind a pacesetter is to set the pace and as runners, we don't get ahead of the pacesetter our aim is to follow and match the pace He sets.

Why are we to look to Jesus?

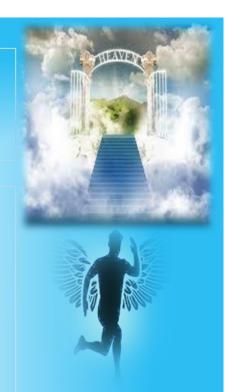
- * He also ran the Spiritual ultramarathon of life.
