



WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A Witness of our faith?

As followers of the Lord Jesus, we are called to serve as "witnesses" to our faith.

To be a witness to Christ is to demonstrate by our <u>words</u>, <u>actions</u> and <u>attitude</u> our faith in that which we have "seen", heard, and believe in our hearts about the Lord who has forgiven us of our sins and through whom we now have received eternal life.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A Witness of our faith?

We testify to our faith more effectively in our actions than in our words, inviting people not simply to understand what we are saying but to meet the Lord, personally and powerfully, through our faith, hope, and love in Him.

AMBASSADORS OF CHRIST Witness

INTETNION THAT WE WOULD LEAD OTHERS TO COME TO KNOW CHRIST & BE SAVED (1 Peter 2:21)

²¹To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. ²² "He committed no sin, & no deceit was found in his mouth."
²³ When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate;

when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.

24 "He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross,

so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness;

"by his wounds you have been healed." ²⁵ For "you were like sheep going astray," [f] but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.






EVERYTHING WE NEED IS IN GOD'S WORD.

SCREENTIME VS BIBLETIME


Q: Did you know you can open your phone and see how long you've spent daily on your phone, on specific apps, etc?
