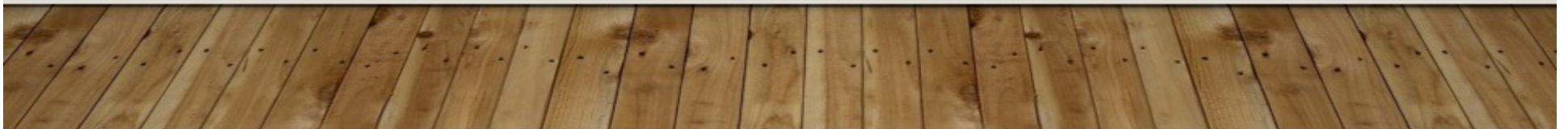

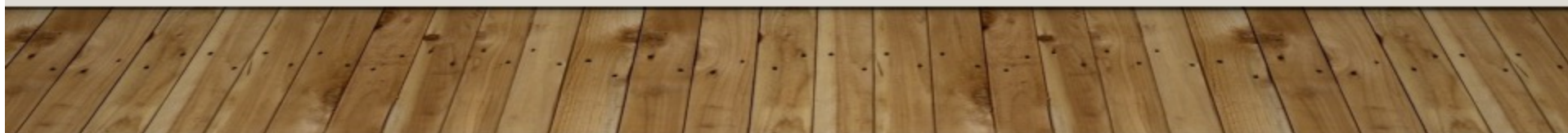

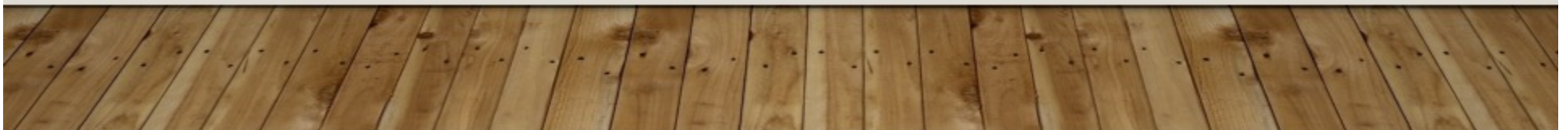
SHOES TAKEN OFF BEFORE ENTERING A HOME

TAKE SHOES OFF BEFORE ENTERING TEMPLE



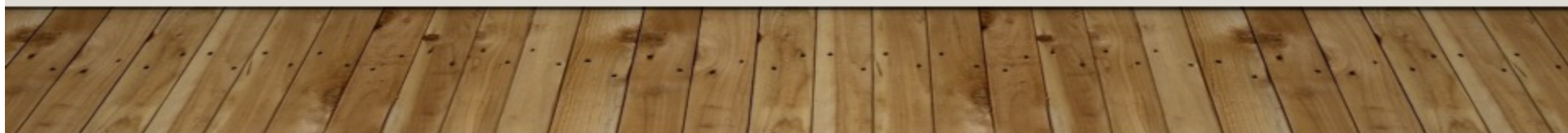

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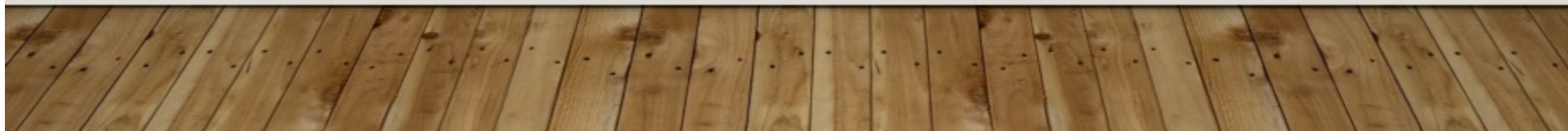

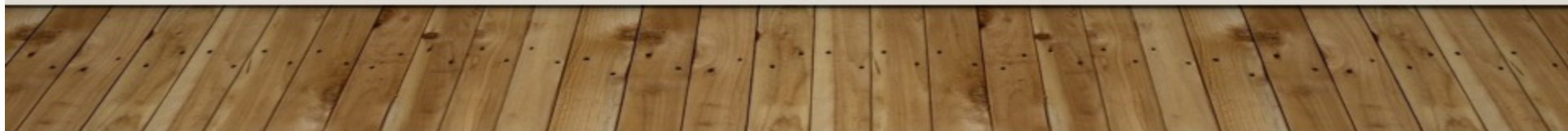


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1 Corínthians 6:9-11

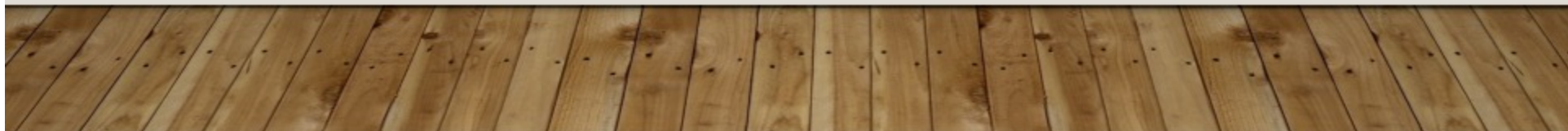

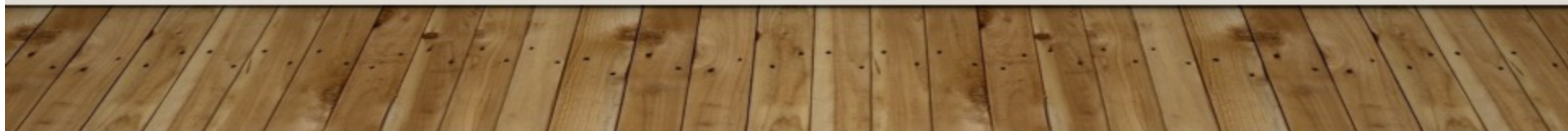


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2 Thessalonians 3:6

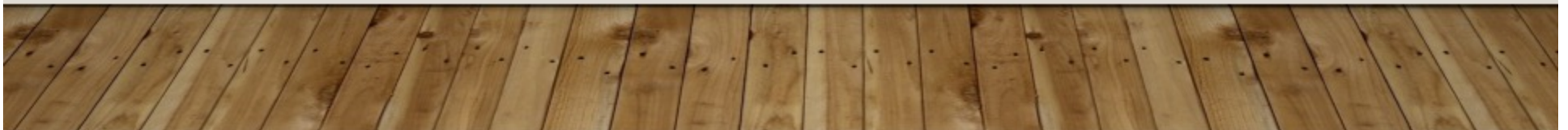

Those Who Are Proud or Arrogant



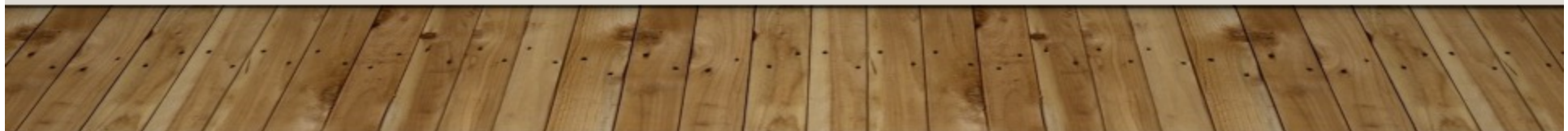


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Proverbs 6:16-17

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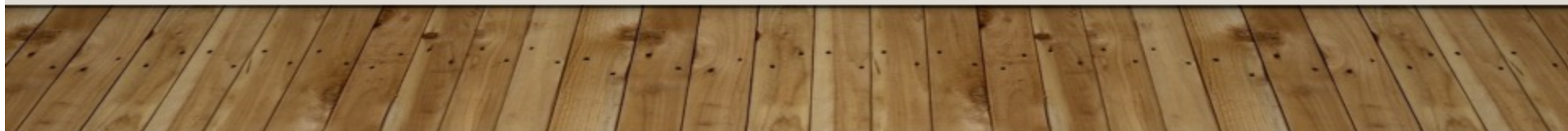


Proverbs 11:2

*“The Lord detests all the **proud** of heart. Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished.”*





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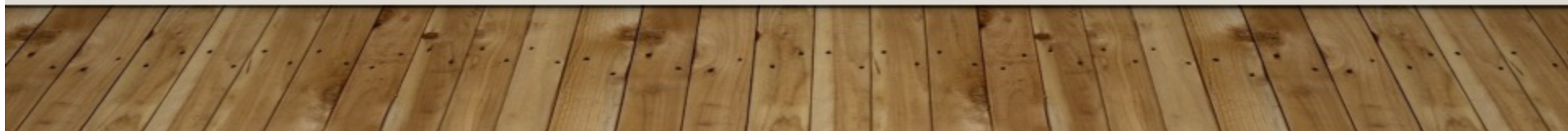

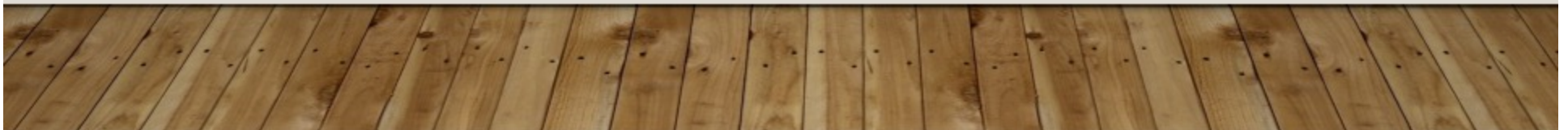

The Hypocrites, Those who Pretend



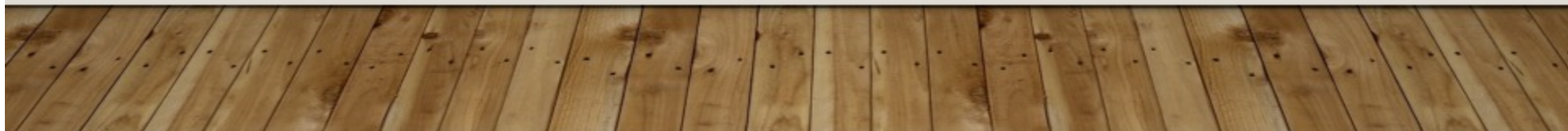


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Romans 2:21-22, 24

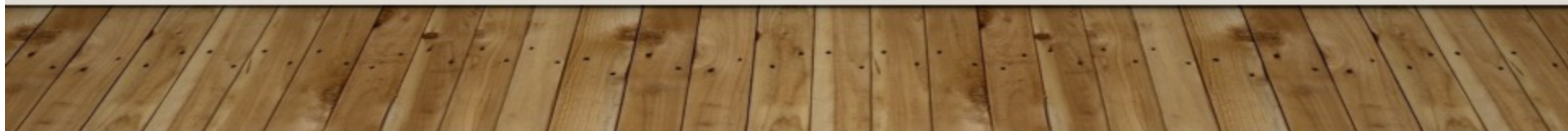

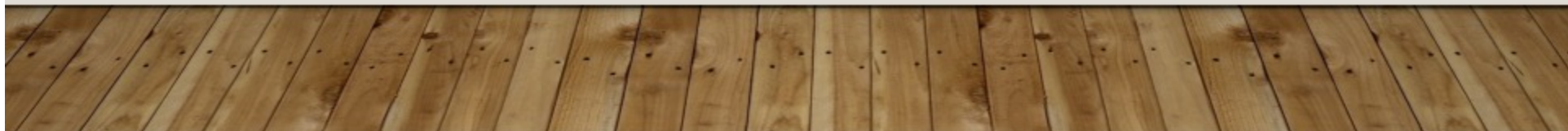

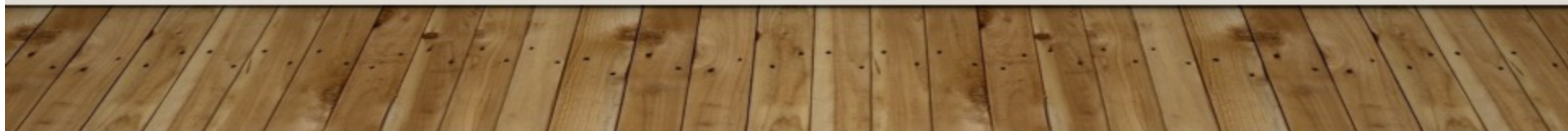


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Matthew 23:27-28

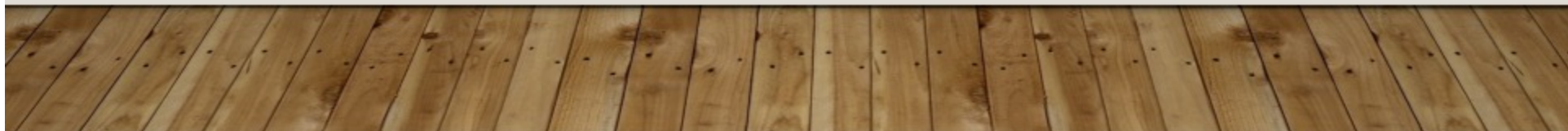

“They profess to know God, but by their actions [their deeds], they deny him. They are detestable, disobedient, and worthless [unfit] for doing anything good.”



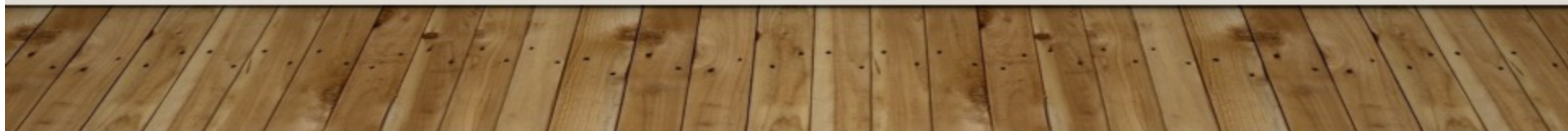

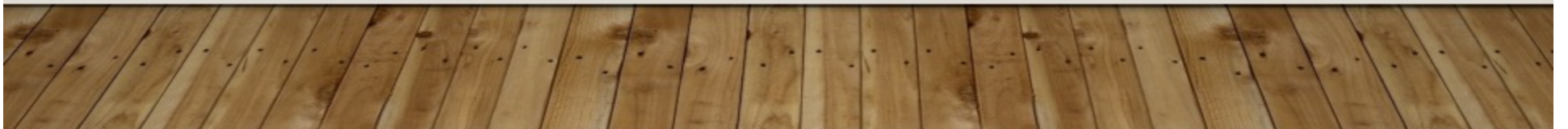


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Loafers

Those Who Are Slothful or Lazy



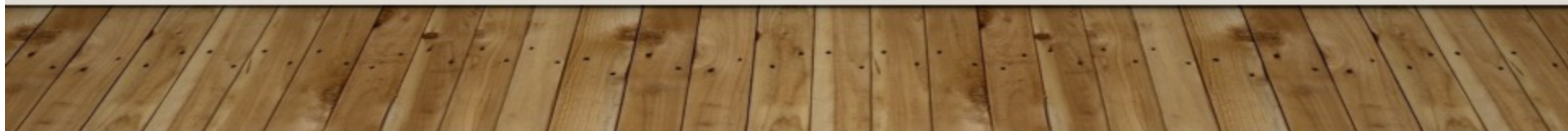


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Ecclesiastes 10:18

drops through.”*





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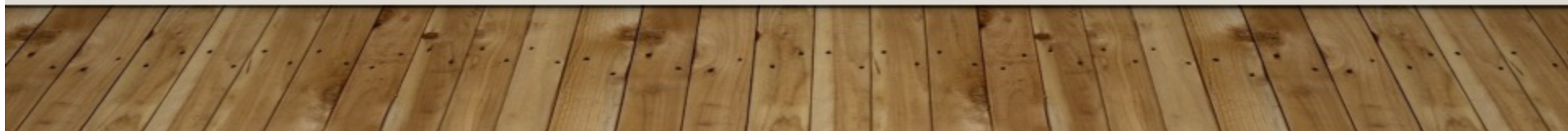

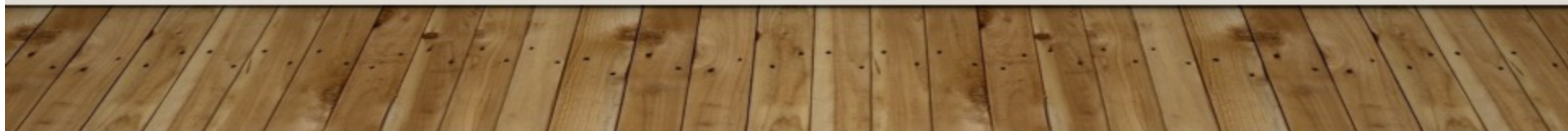

Those Secret or Devious Ones





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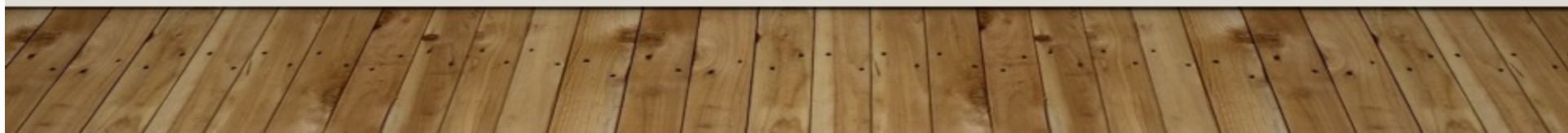

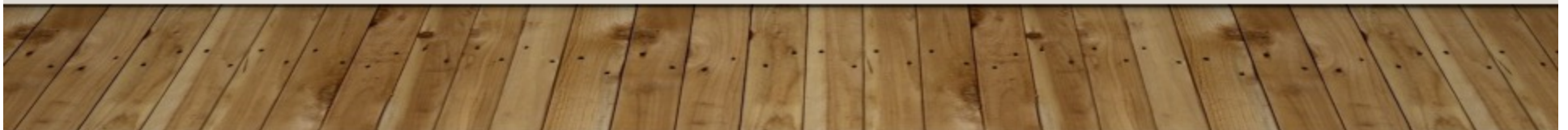


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Slippers

Those who slip or backslide





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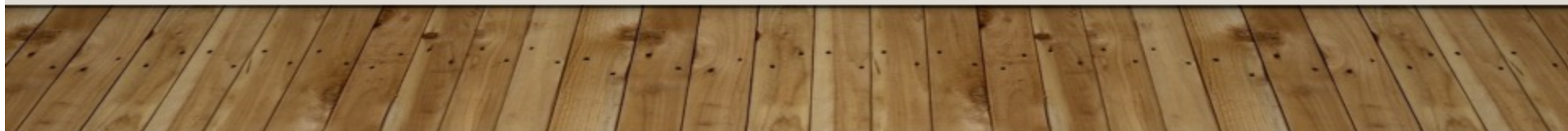


Psalm 38:16

*“If I should say, ‘My foot has **slipped** Your lovingkindness, O Lord, will hold me up.’”*



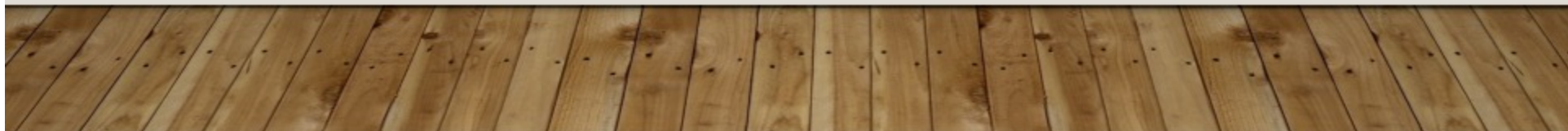
