Why is this the FIRST & GREATEST commandment?



JOHN 3: <u>16</u>-17

FOR GOD SO LOVED....

16) For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever should believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.17) For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.



JOHN 3: 18-21

Men loved darkness rather than light because their deeds were evil...

18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. 19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed. 21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

Last time I was before you, we looked at what it means to be a faithful witness. To follow Jesus' example. To live a life that points others to Christ.


Today we are going to look at the ROOT of it all. What makes ONE decide to be a faithful witness and the OTHER a hostile witness?

Let's read it together.








the Lord."

- 1. Get to know and understand how much God LOVES you.
- 2. Search your heart is there anything you love more than God?
 - -you can identify these things by asking yourself where you spend the majority of your time, thoughts, energy, and effort?
- 3. Prune any branches on your tree that need to be pruned.
 - -Anything or anyone that pulls you away from Christ? That encourages you to sin? Anything that distracts you from living your life more excellently in Christ?
- 4. Develop a deep reverence for God.
- -Is there anything you fear more than you fear God? Is He Lord of your life?
- 5. Spend (significant) time renewing your mind and establishing your identity in Christ.
