







Carry your cross by **faith** in Christ

Take up your cross by God's grace





No Gospel Galatians 1:6-9

6I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel 7which is really **no gospel** at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ.

8But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse! 9As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let them be under God's curse!

What is the problem?

Certain Jewish Christians (Judaizers) were teaching Gentile converts that Paul's gospel was not correct. They stated that circumcision and keeping the law of Moses was necessary for salvation.

In writing this epistle to the Gentile churches that he founded, Paul was compelled to counter the false doctrine and false gospel introduced by the Judaizers.


Therefore, he encouraged the Galatians to hold on to the true gospel of salvation which many embraced and accepted by hearing with faith during his earlier visit.



APPLICATION

Believers are to **witness** to others by faith that they can experience peace with God from being justified by faith through Jesus Christ our Lord.





Refute the Judaizers teaching

Paul wrote to the Galatians to refute the Judaizers teaching that it was necessary for Gentile converts to be a Jew before they could be a Christian by requiring them to be circumcised and keep the law of Moses for salvation.

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-4

Read Romans 1:16

Refute the Judaizers teaching

1Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand.

2By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

3For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

4that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

Refute the Judaizers teaching

16For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the **power of God unto salvation** to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 1:16

Reveal the false doctrine of the Judaizers

Paul wrote to the Galatians to reveal to them that the combination of faith **plus** works are not the requirements for salvation. Man cannot save himself, but he can be saved by **grace** through **faith**, alone.

Read Acts 15:11

Read Ephesians 2:8-9

Reveal the false doctrine of the Judaizers

11But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

Acts 15:11

Reveal the false doctrine of the Judaizers

8For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9

Defend the truth of the Gospel

Paul wrote Galatians to **defend** the truth of the gospel by demonstrating that the law brings a curse but he who puts his faith in Christ shall be delivered from that curse.

Read Deuteronomy 27:26

Read Galatians 3:11

Defend the truth of the Gospel

26Anyone who does not put the words of this law into practice is cursed.' And all the people will say, 'Amen!'

Deuteronomy 27:26

Defend the truth of the Gospel

11Clearly no one who relies on the law is justified before God, because "the righteous will live by faith."

Galatians 3:11

Emphasize justification by faith

Paul wrote to the Galatians to **emphasize** he who is justified by faith, rather than works, shall live and is set free from the curse of the law and the control of the law.

Read Galatians 2:16

Read Romans 5:1

Emphasize justification by faith


16Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 2:16

Emphasize justification by faith

1Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Romans 5:1
