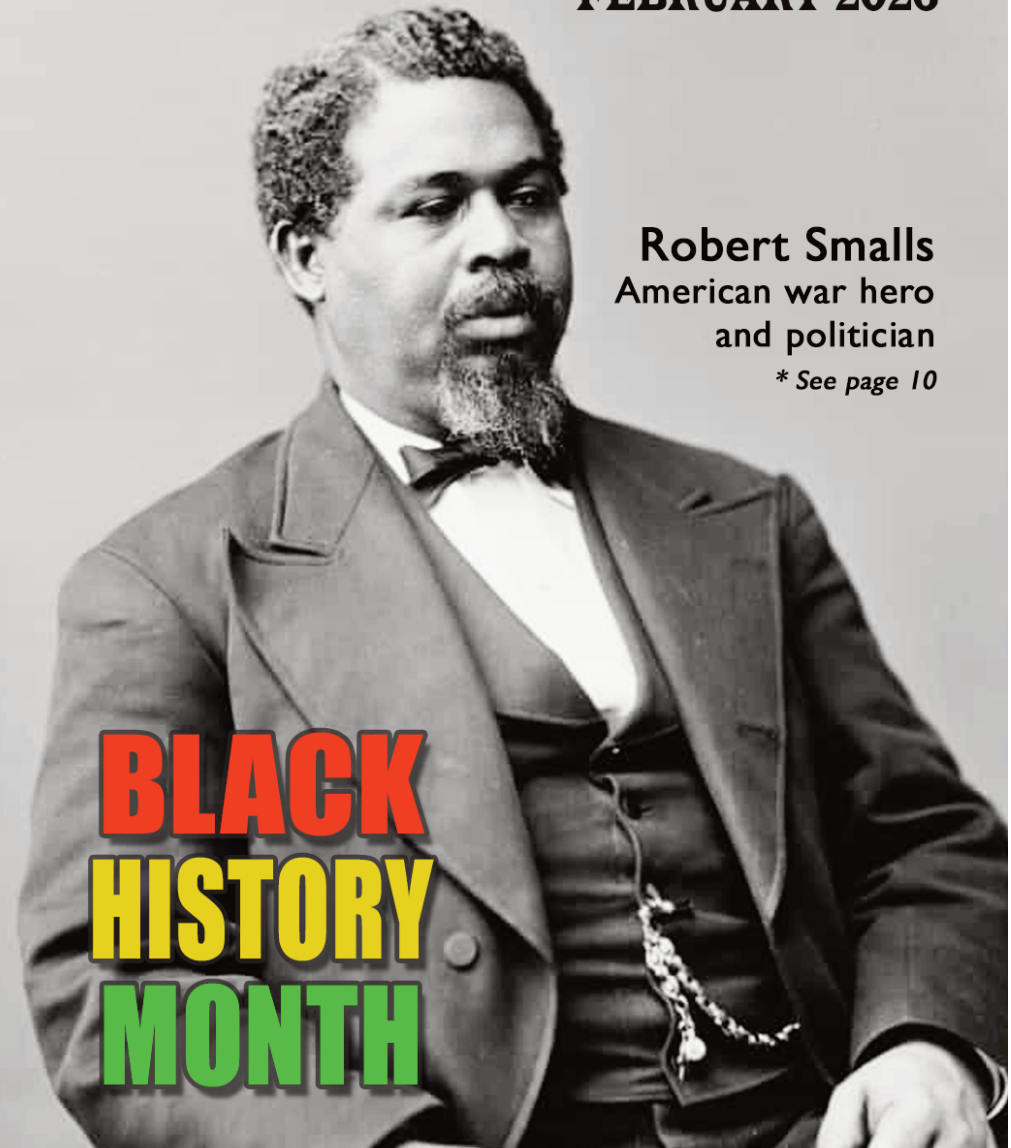

Beulah's Mission Statement

Beulah is a missional church in the heart of Crown Heights, Brooklyn, ministering to the total person. A church that is evangelistic, inclusive, compassionate and reproductive.

Robert Smalls was a former enslaved person who became a war hero, politician, and advocate for education and civil rights.

1. Daring Escape: On May 13, 1862, Robert Smalls commandeered the Confederate transport ship, the CSS Planter, and sailed it to freedom, successfully navigating past five Confederate forts. This act not only secured his own freedom but also that of his family and others on board.

2. First African American Captain: After his escape, Smalls served in the Union Navy and became the first African American captain of a U.S. Navy vessel, commanding the USS Planter.

3. Political Career: Following the Civil War, Smalls was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives, where he served multiple terms during the Reconstruction era. He was a founding member of

the Republican Party of South Carolina and worked to secure civil rights for African Americans.

4. Education Advocate: Smalls authored legislation that established South Carolina's first free and compulsory public school system, making significant contributions to education in the state.

5. Legacy: Robert Smalls' life story is a testament to resilience and leadership. He is remembered as a symbol of courage and determination, inspiring future generations to fight for their rights and freedoms.


These facts highlight Robert Smalls' remarkable journey from slavery to becoming a prominent figure in American history, showcasing his bravery and commitment to justice and equality. □
