- Plan and execute large scale events for youth such as, but not limited to, Summer Camps, Retreats, Missions Trips and Conferences.
- Regularly be present at students' games, concerts, plays etc...

- Excellent teamwork and management abilities for ministry teams and multiple projects. Effective and relational written and communication skills for all areas of ministry.

- Proficiency in basic computer applications and willingness to learn new software or systems as needed.
- Effective skills in time management, organization, self-initiative and working under pressure.
- Self-motivated to study and improve knowledge and skill in areas of responsibility. Ability to research/analyze information appropriate for church ministry.
- Ability to adapt, flex, and shift in response to changing priorities, fluctuating deadlines, and interruptions.
- Display emotional health-be willing to undergo personal traits evaluations as part of the onboarding process such as Enneagram & DISC.
- Set a standard of timely completion for all ministry, budget, and project deadlines through exemplary planning.
- Be fully present and prepared for all team & project meetings.
- Display integrous financial management practices.
- To work cross departmentally and in partnership with other East Hill ministries.
- To actively participate in all staff meetings and activities.
- To participate in Pastoral Care Team duties and obligations.
- Other duties as assigned.
