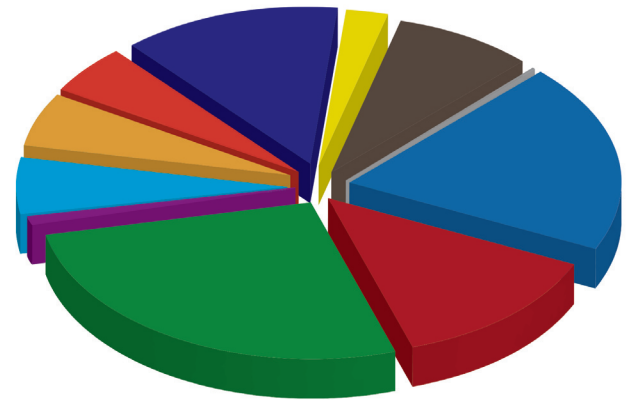
FINANCIAL SUMMARY 2021-2022

La Salle Academy is deeply grateful to our Board of Trustees and to our Benefactors who have made the 2021-2022 year a fundraising success as we worked our way out of COVID 19 Pandemic-mode. Because of your generosity, La Salle Academy was able to reach our fundraising goals. Our school community was LSA Proud. We are sincerely thankful for your help in making a difference in each of our students' lives. LSA spent \$2,250,000 on general operations, our Academic Program, the Education Plus Health program and educational supports.

Gifts and Donations by Source of Funds

During the fiscal year 2021-2022, La Salle Academy received approximately \$1,000,000 in unrestricted donations, \$1,500,000 in restricted Scholarship and Sponsor A Student funds; \$250,000 in donations and restricted funds for the LSA Graduate Support program. A long time friend and benefactor created a Trade School and College Assistance Fund.

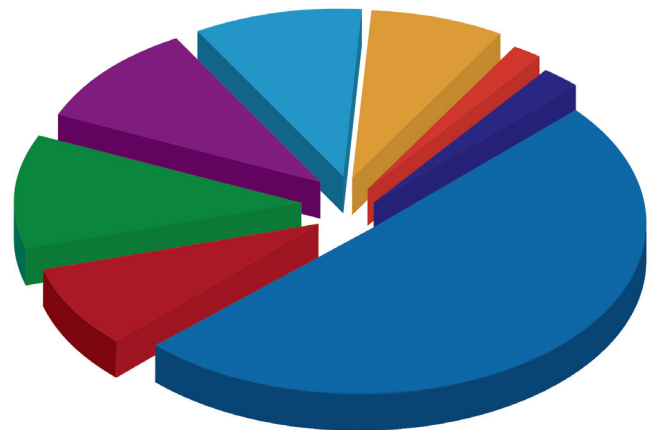

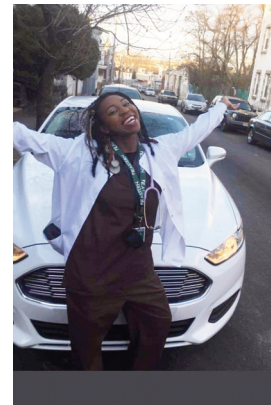
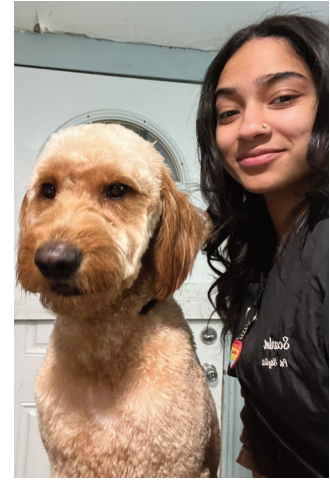
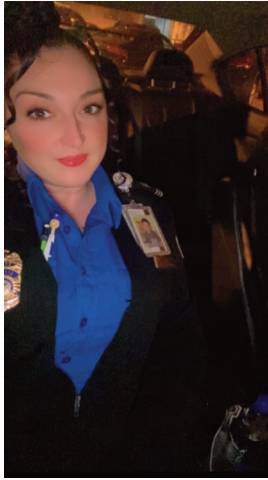
LA SALLE ACADEMY PROUD GOLF OUTING

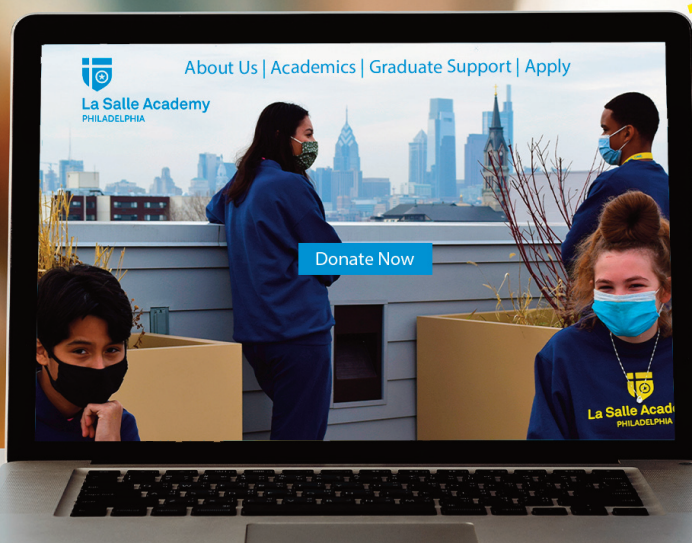
Summer Olympics at LSA
