1. A full **house**

[Mark 2:1-2]

- Read 2 Chronicles 5:13-14 and Revelation 7:9-12.
 - o Why do you think God is pleased when there is a "full house"?
- Pastor Dary asked, "Are people hungry for God?"
 - o Read Psalm 63:1-5, Matthew 5:6, Matthew 22:8-10.
 - o What do you think it is about Jesus that fulfills our hunger?

2. Meet the **team**.

[Mark 2:3]

- Tell about a time you accomplished something with a team.
- Who do you look for to team up with?
 - o Read about Paul's team in **Romans 16:1-19.** What stands out to you?
- What do you give up when you're part of a team?
 - o Read Matthew 19:27 and John 6:68-69.
 - O What are you working on now (a "mat" or "bridge") with a team?

3. The mentality: **Never Give Up**. [Mark 2:4]

- Read and discuss Luke 18:35-42, John 12:20-23, Romans 5:1-5, and James 1:2-4.
- Pastor Dary asked us, "In what ways might I be blocking a clear view of God?"

4. Your **faith** impacts others. [Mark 2:5]

- Read **1 Thessalonians 1:4-10** and discuss the following ideas in light of those verses:
 - o What impact does my behavior, faith, and attitude have on others?
 - O What can I do to grow in these ways?

5. Are you a **fan** or a **critic**? [Mark 2:6-7]

- It can be easier to criticize (**Proverbs 15:1**) but wise advice is valuable (**Proverbs 25:11**).
- If you had been in the full house when the paralytic was forgiven and healed, how would you have responded to Jesus's words?

6. Give God a chance. [Mark 2:8-11]

• Read Exodus 14:10-14 and 2 Kings 6:15-17.

- What do I need in order to welcome God's provision?
- When have you given "one more chance" for God to solve your problem?

7. A victory
