What is one thing that really stood out to you in Pastor Dary's message?

Read **Acts 3:1-11**.

1. What is a **nudge?**

- How would you describe a "nudge" from the Holy Spirit?
- How can you discern between a nudge from the Holy Spirit and your own idea?

2. The **Holy Spirit** was poured out in Acts 2.

- Read Joel 2:28-32, Matthew 3:11, John 14:25-27, John 20:21-22, Acts 1:4-8, Acts 2:1-22, Acts 10:34-48, Acts 19:1-6.
- Discuss these scriptures and how they apply to us today.

3. Be aware of the **normal day.**

- Read **Acts 8:26-39.** How did Philip follow the prompting of the Holy Spirit?
- How can I be ready for this "nudge" that Pastor Dary talked about?
- Rhetorically, am I *actually* willing to be more involved in ways the Spirit might lead?
 - o If not, what can help me change?

4. Engagement at the appropriate time...

- Read **Proverbs 3:3-7** and **lames 1:5**.
- We need God's wisdom to discern between "eager-beaver me" and the Holy Spirit.

5. How can I personally get involved?

- Pastor Dary said, "The nudge can't be planned, but it can be missed." Discuss this.
- Share briefly about a time when you responded to a nudge from God or missed it.
- Read **Acts 3:19-20** and **2 Corinthians 5:17-21.** Discuss what motivates us to get involved in what God is doing.

6. To God be the glory.

• Read 1 Corinthians 2:1-5.
