John 8:1-12 I <sup>1</sup> But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. <sup>2</sup> Early in the morning He came again to the temple. All the people came to Him, and He sat down and taught them. <sup>3</sup> The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the midst <sup>4</sup> they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery. <sup>5</sup> Now in the Law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do you say?" <sup>6</sup> This they said to test Him, that they might have some charge to bring against Him. Jesus bent down and wrote with His finger on the ground. <sup>7</sup> And as they continued to ask Him, He stood up and said to them, "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." <sup>8</sup> And once more He bent down and wrote on the ground. <sup>9</sup> But when they heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before Him. <sup>10</sup> Jesus stood up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" <sup>11</sup> She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more." <sup>12</sup> Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (Leviticus 23:33-44)

Matthew 15:8-9 I "This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me; in vain do they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men." (Romans 3:23, 1 Corinthians 3:18)
✓ Jesus sees us as those who need to be (v. 7-12)
Matthew 9:36 I When He saw the crowds, He had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. (Luke 19:10, Ephesians 2:1)
