YOU CAN'T. GOD CAN.

Joshua 14:6-15 | 6 Then the people of Judah came to Joshua at Gilgal. And Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite said to him, "You know what the Lord said to Moses the man of God in Kadesh-barnea concerning you and me. ⁷I was forty years old when Moses the servant of the Lord sent me from Kadesh-barnea to spy out the land, and I brought him word again as it was in my heart. 8 But my brothers who went up with me made the heart of the people melt; yet I wholly followed the Lord my God. 9 And Moses swore on that day, saying, 'Surely the land on which your foot has trodden shall be an inheritance for you and your children forever, because you have wholly followed the Lord my God.' 10 And now, behold, the Lord has kept me alive, just as He said, these forty-five years since the time that the Lord spoke this word to Moses, while Israel walked in the wilderness. And now, behold, I am this day eightyfive years old. ¹¹ I am still as strong today as I was in the day that Moses sent me; my strength now is as my strength was then, for war and for going and coming. 12 So now give me this hill country of which the Lord spoke on that day, for you heard on that day how the Anakim were there, with great fortified cities. It may be that the Lord will be with me, and I shall drive them out just as the Lord said." 13 Then Joshua blessed him, and he gave Hebron to Caleb the son of Jephunneh for an inheritance. 14 Therefore Hebron became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite to this day, because he wholly followed the Lord, the God of Israel. 15 Now the name of Hebron formerly was Kiriath-arba. (Arba was the greatest man among the Anakim.) And the land had rest from war.

Hebrew 11:1-3 | • Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. • For by it the people of old received their commendation. • By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

1. You can't see what the Lord sees without faith. v. 6-7

2 Corinthians 4:18 | As we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal. [2 Kings 6:17, Ephesians 1:18]

2. It requires zero faith to grumble. v. 8-9

John 6:61-64 | 61 But Jesus, knowing in Himself that His disciples were grumbling about this, said to them, "Do you take offense at this? 62 Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where He was before? 65 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life. 64 But there are some of you who do not believe." [Numbers 13, 1 Corinthians 10:6-13]

3. It takes faith to give what you got for the Lord. v. 10-12a

Luke 6:38 | Give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you. [Acts 4:36-37, Romans 12:1]

4. It is impossible to please the Lord without faith. v. 12b-13

Hebrew 11:6 | And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him. [1 Corinthians 16:5-9]

5. You can't <u>do</u> what the Lord <u>desires</u> without faith. v. 14-15

James 2:26 | For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead. [James 2:18-25, 1 Corinthians12:9]

Faith necessitates that you <u>believe</u> <u>God</u>, not just in God.
