## The church covenants to support the members with:

- Prayers: prayerfully seek God's will for our church community and steward her resources to the best of our ability based on our study of the Scriptures and following of the Spirit (Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 5:1-4).
- Care: caring for the church and seeking her growth in grace, truth, and love (Matthew 28:16-20; Ephesians 4:15-16, Colossians 1:28; James 5:14; 1 Peter 5:1-4).
- *Teaching:* providing teaching and counsel from the whole of Scripture (Acts 20:27-28; 1 Timothy 4:16; 2 Timothy 4:1-5; Titus 2:1).
- Equipping: equipping the members of the church for the work of ministry (Ephesians 4:11-16).
- Guarding: ensure teaching meets the doctrinal standards of the Global Methodist Church as outlined in the Boof of Doctrines and Discipline (Matthew 7:15; Acts 20: 28-31; 1 Timothy 1:3-7; 1 John 4:1).
- Leading: setting an example and joining members in fulfilling the obligations of church membership stated above (Philippians 3:17; 1 Timothy 4:12; Titus 2:7-8; 1 Peter 5:3).
